

General Surgery Levels of Care

- (1) At the attending faculty's discretion, direct supervision of a more junior resident may be delegated to a senior resident (PGY-4/PGY-5) with the faculty providing indirect supervision.
- (2) Faculty may have any level of resident perform any procedure with direct supervision for which the faculty is credentialed.
- (3) PGY level in table is minimum level at which a resident is allowed to perform a procedure.
