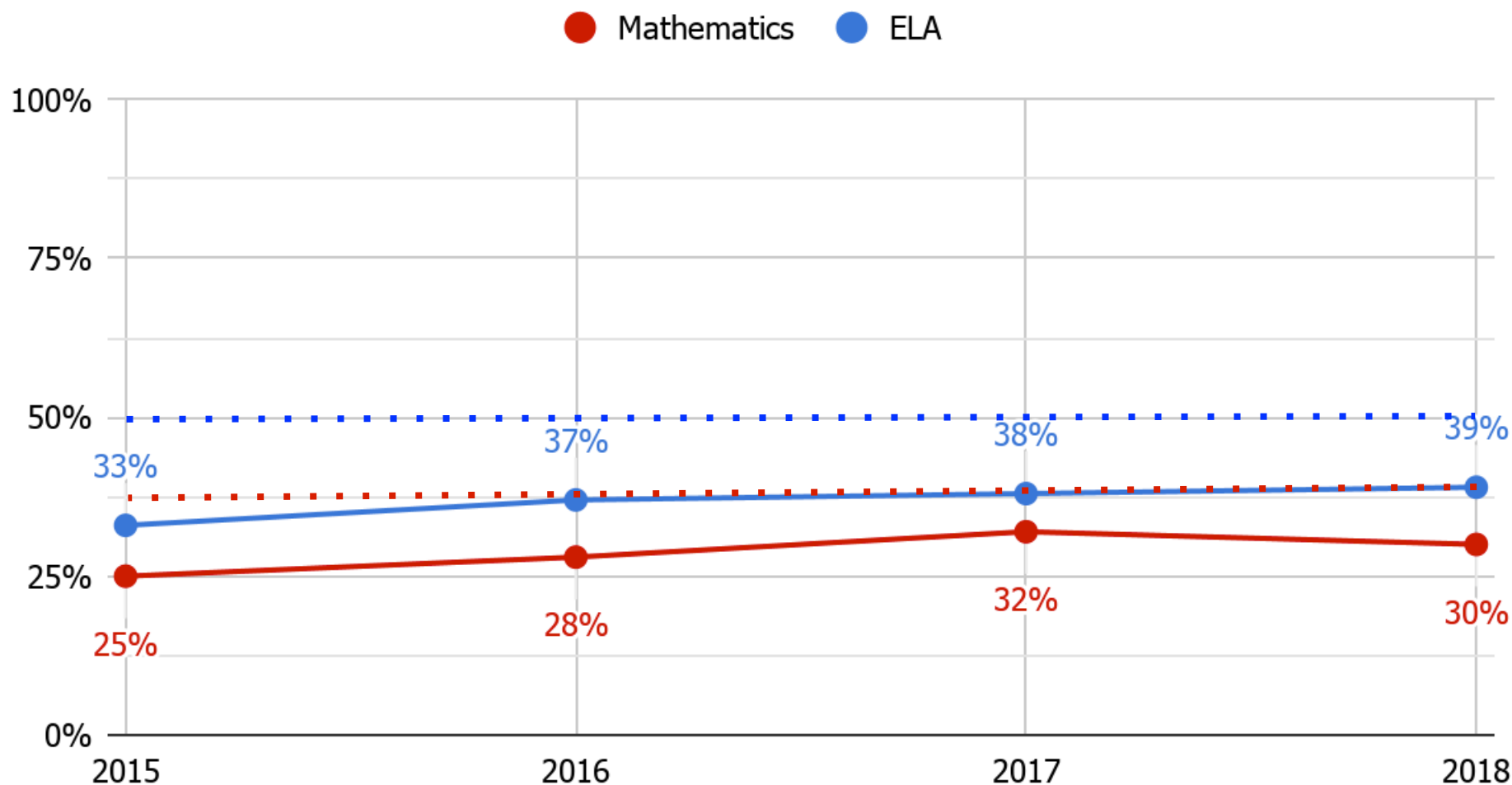

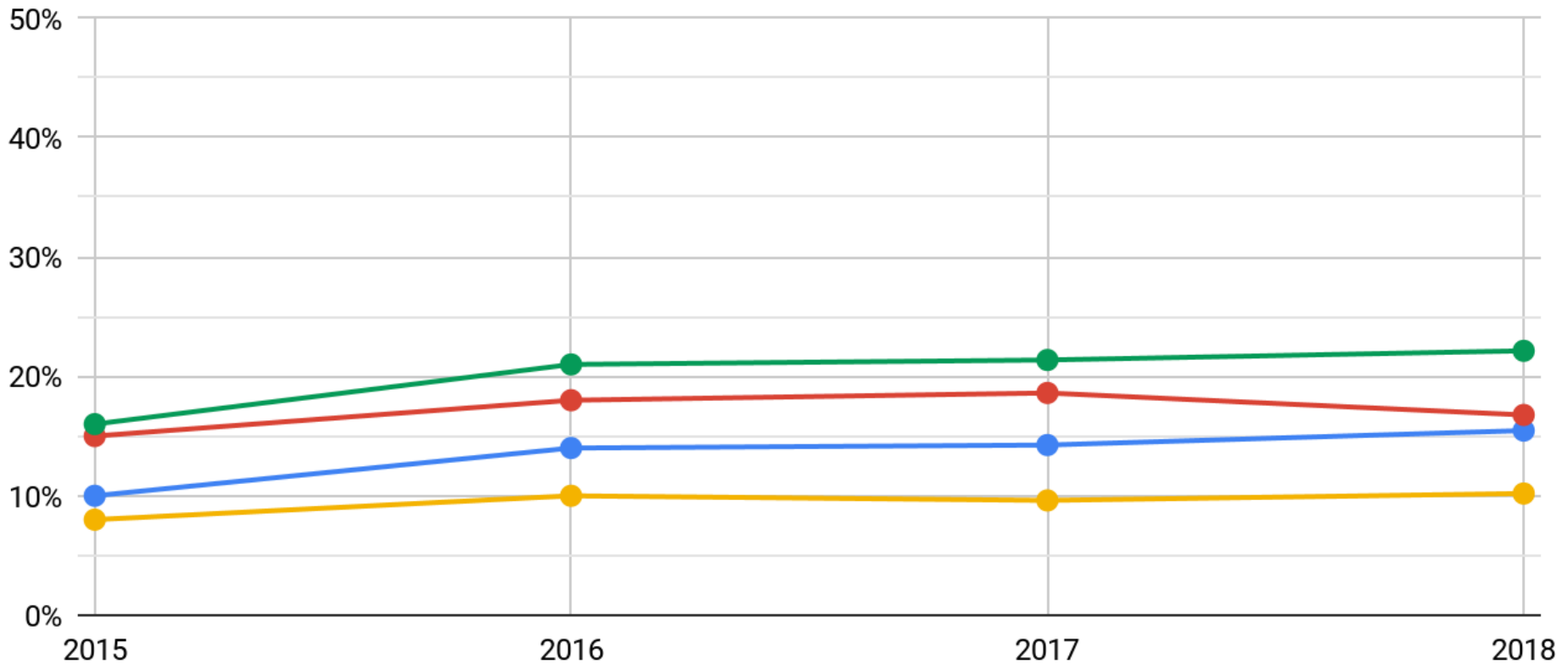

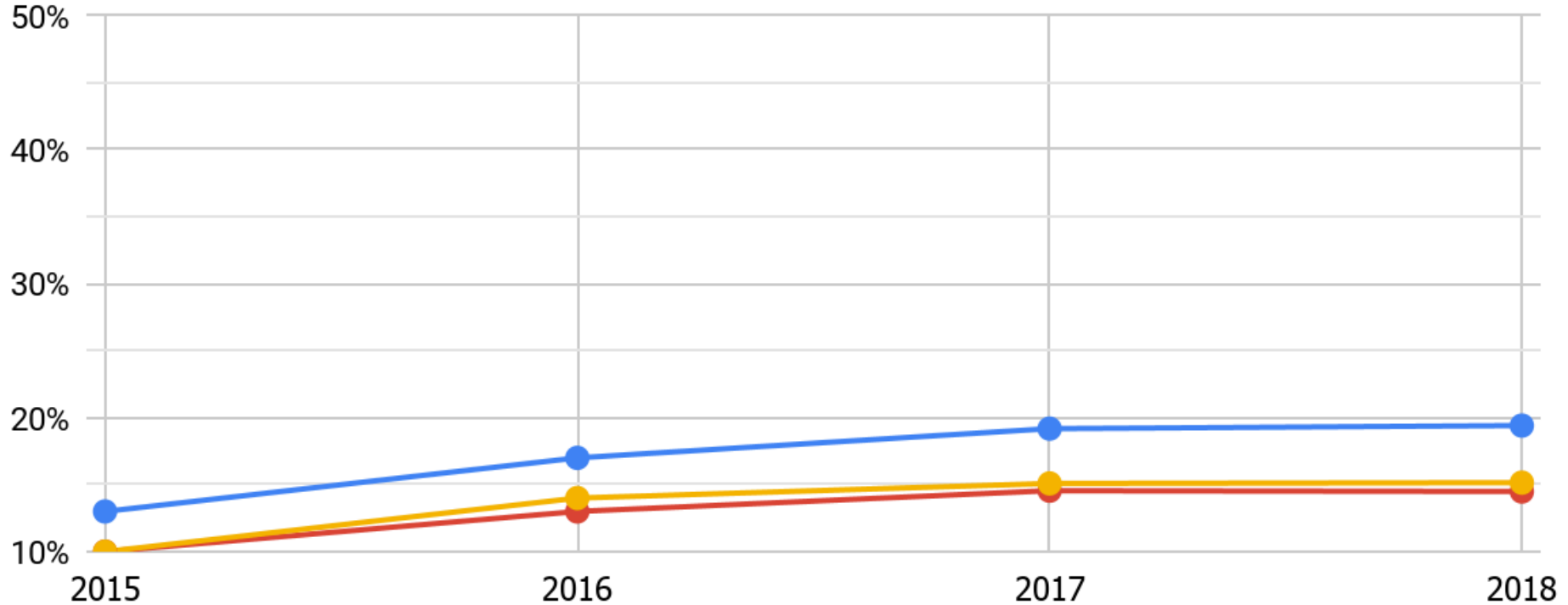

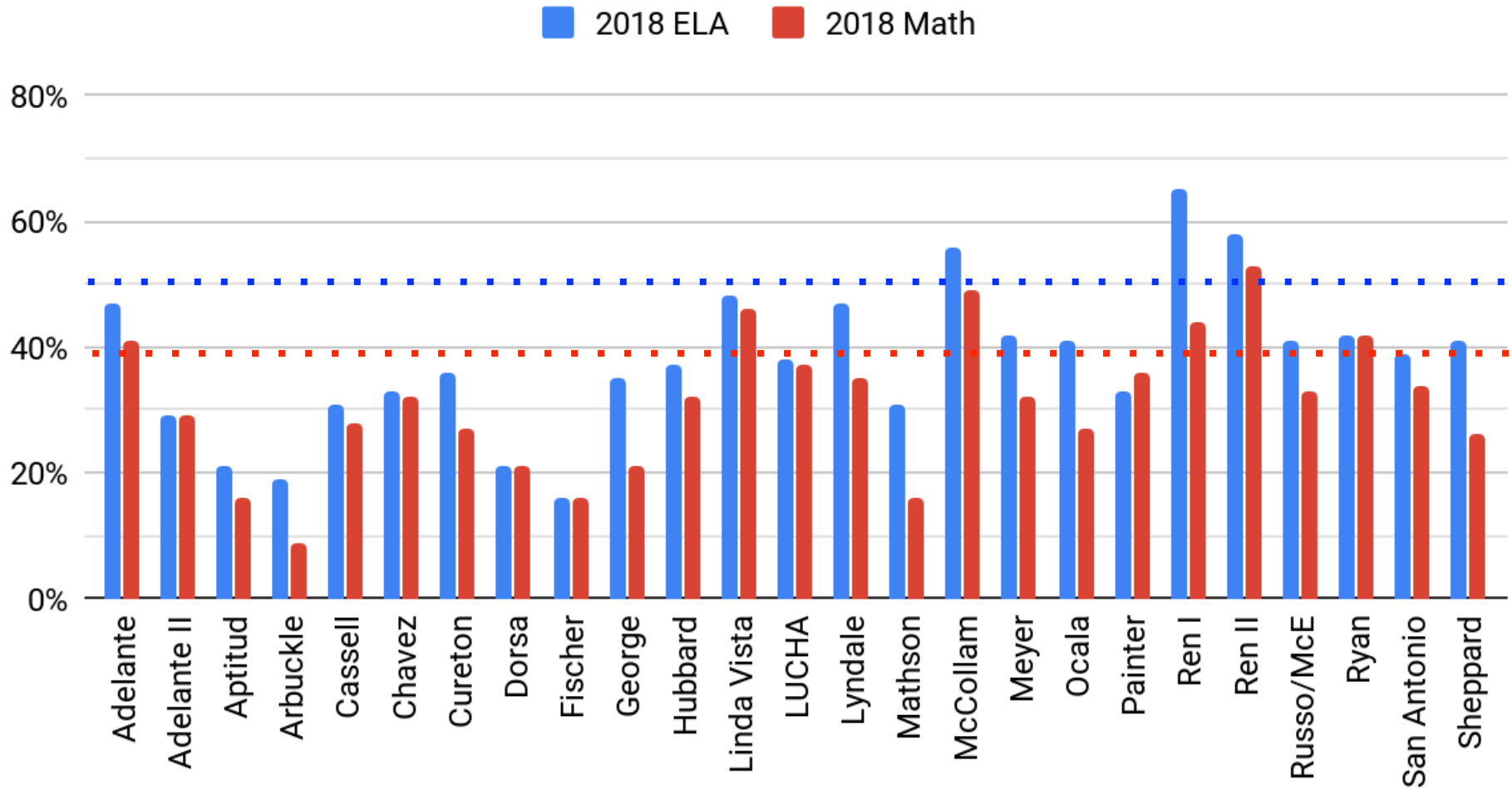

School Achievement Overall

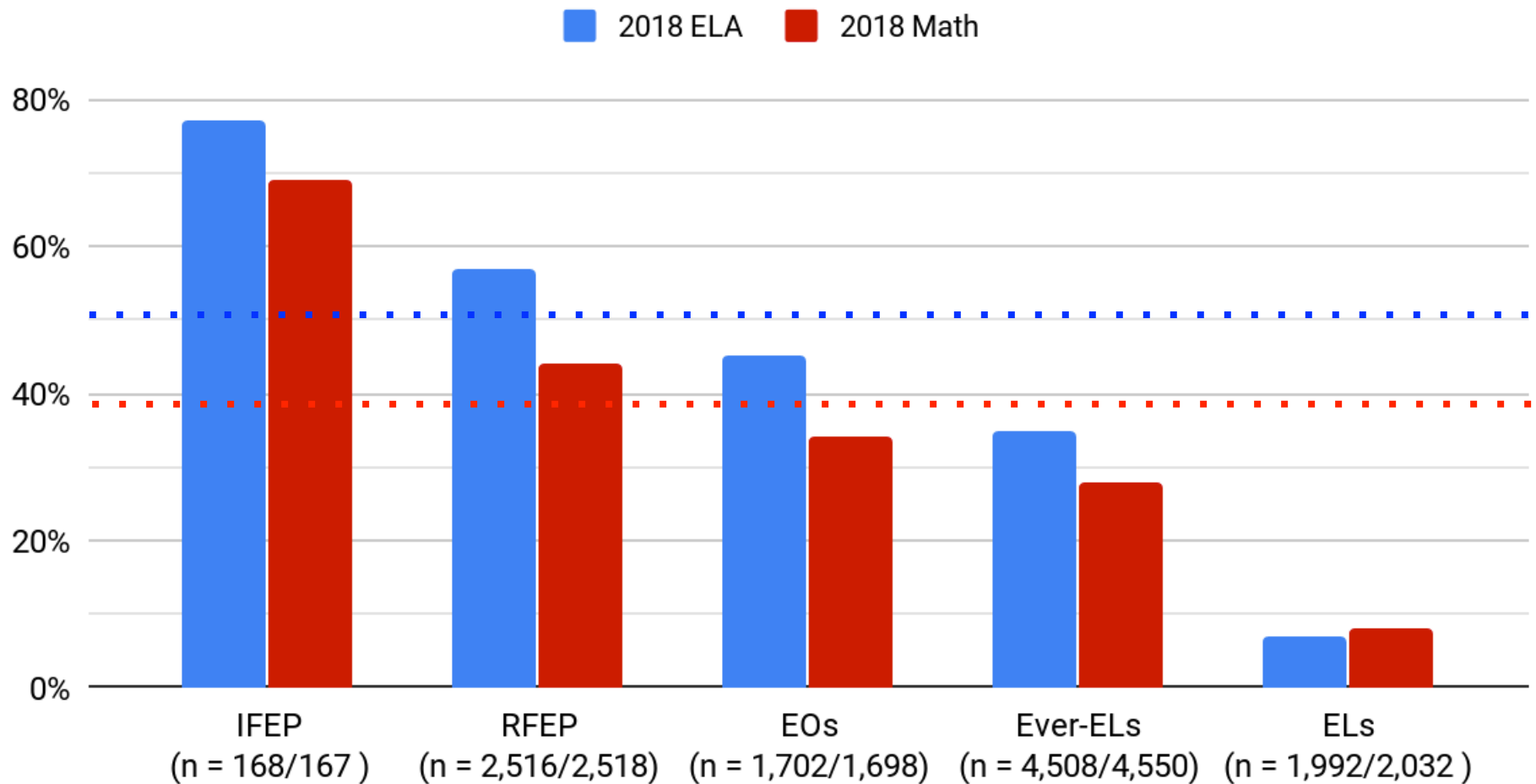
ELA and Mathematics - Met/Exceeded Standard by Site





Language Proficiencies

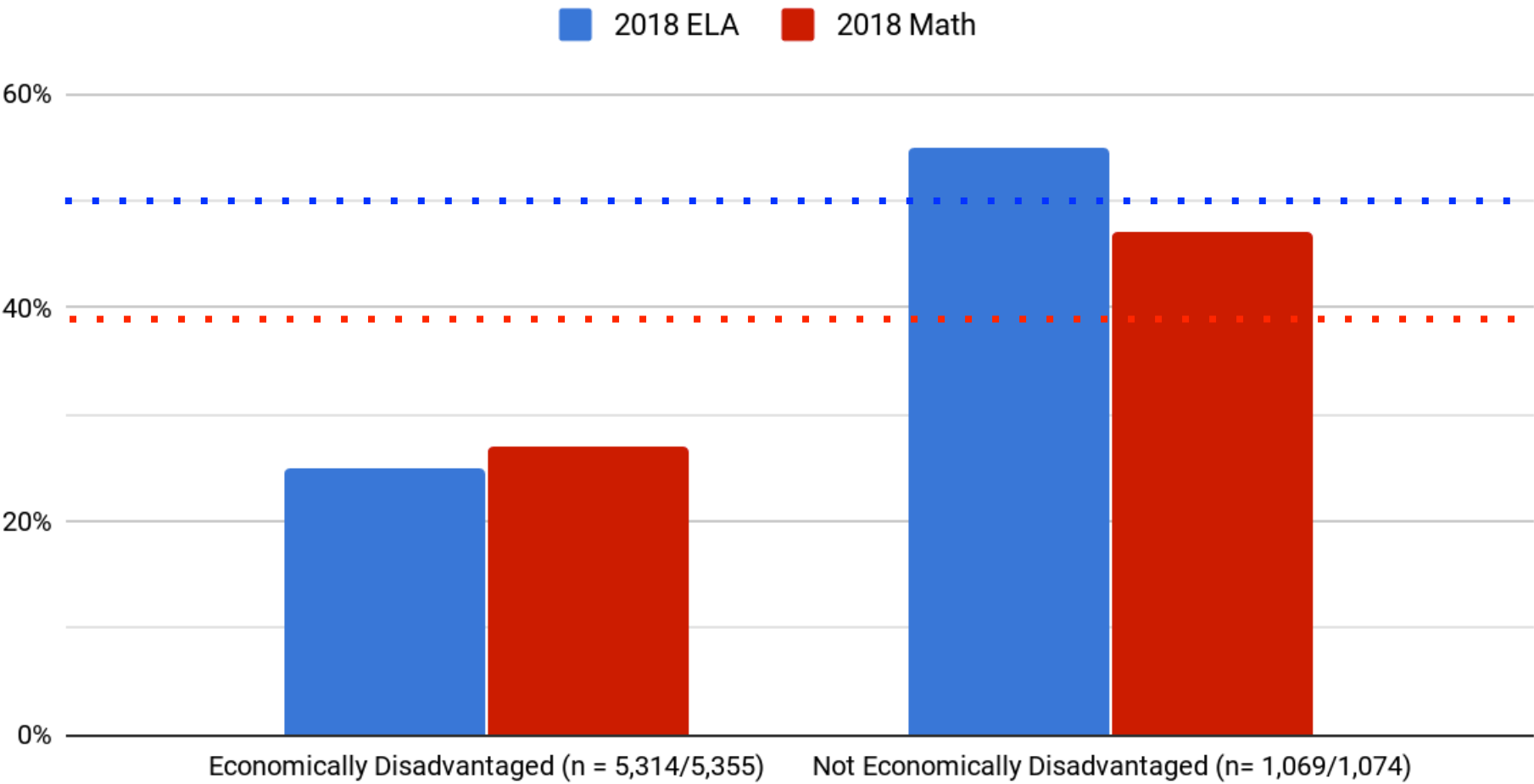
ELA and Mathematics - Met/Exceeded Standard by Language Proficiency





Economic Status

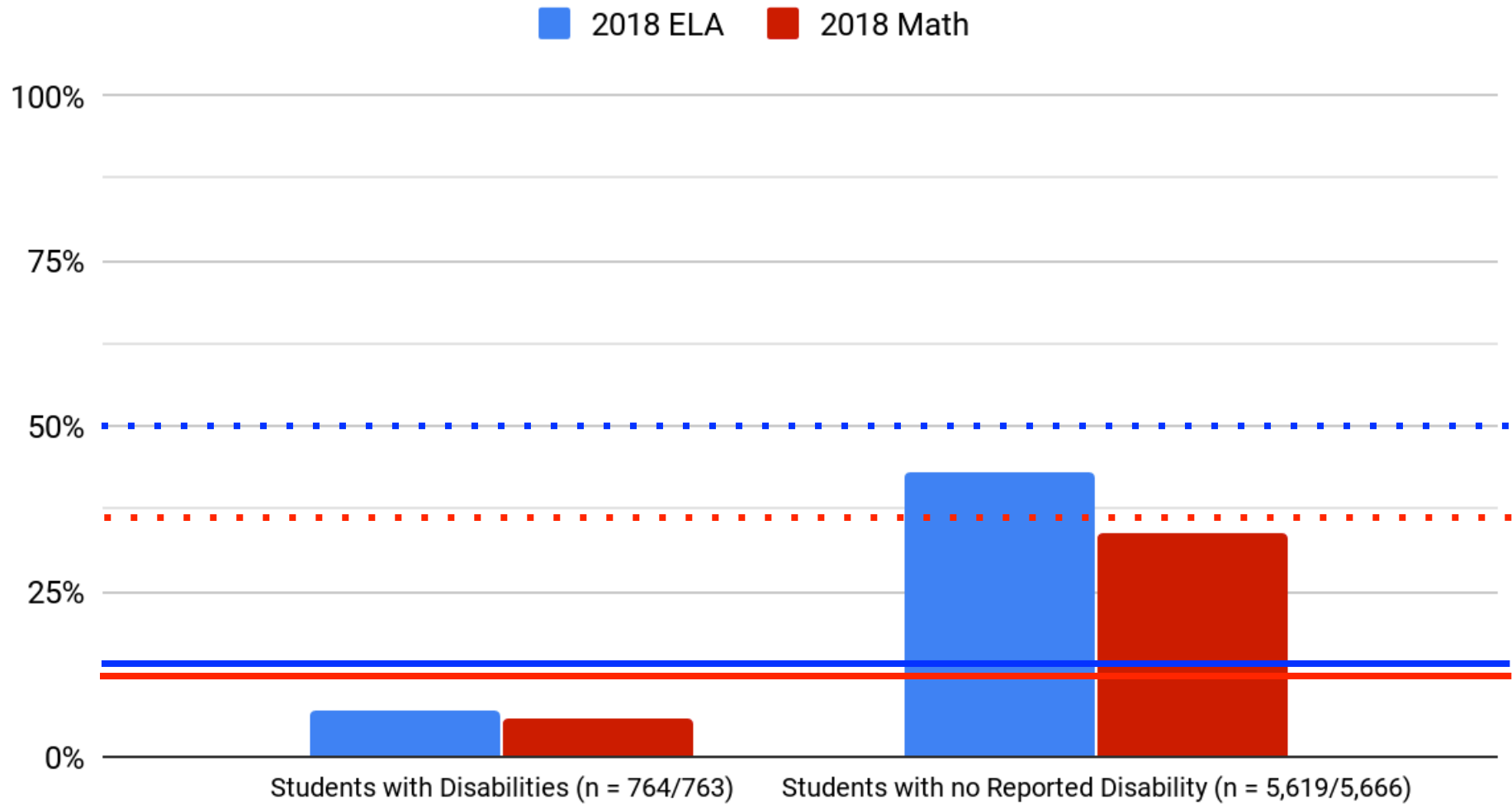
ELA and Mathematics - Met/Exceeded Standard by Economic Status





Disability Status

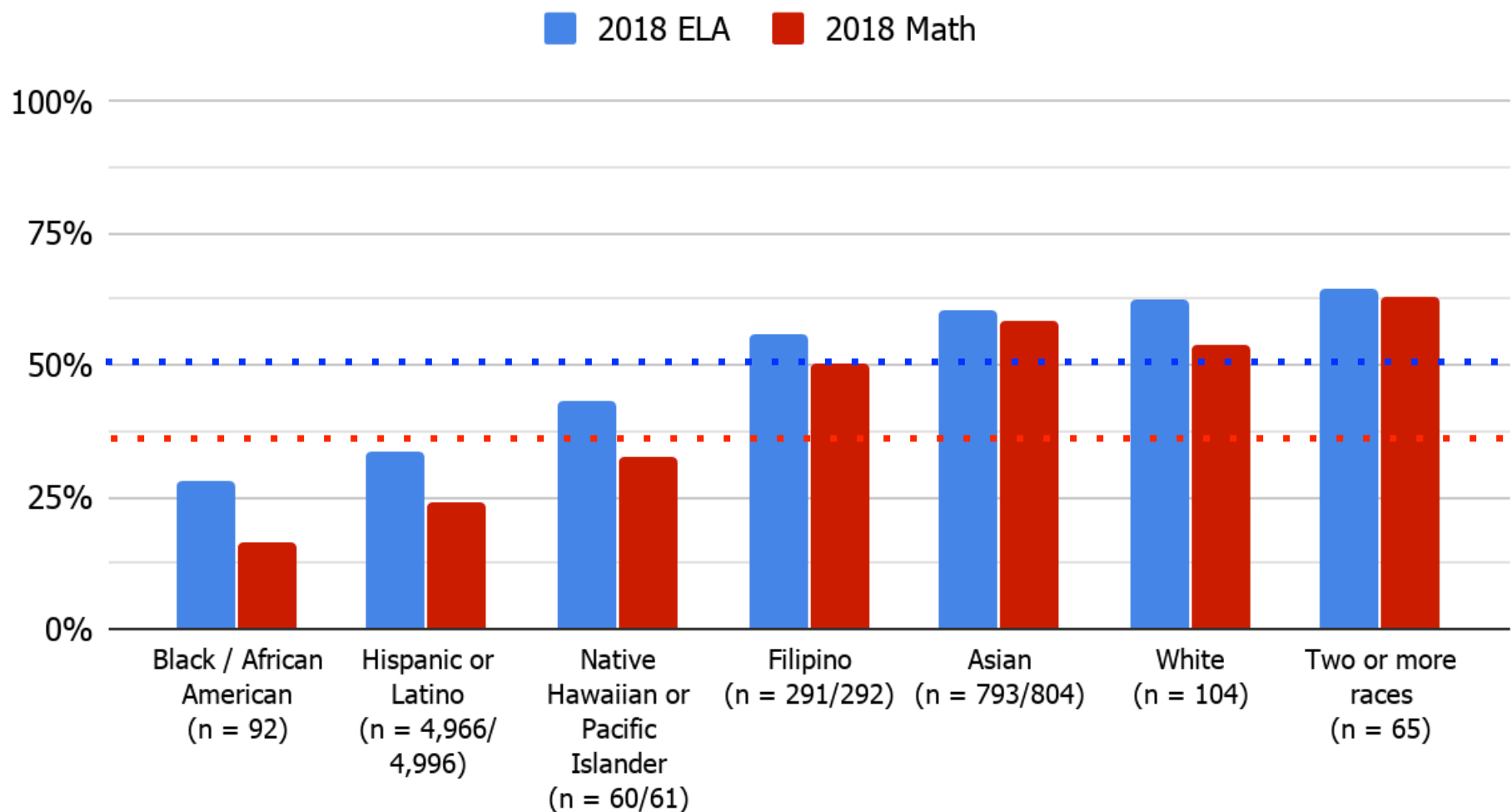
ELA and Mathematics - Met/Exceeded Standard by Disability Status





Ethnicity

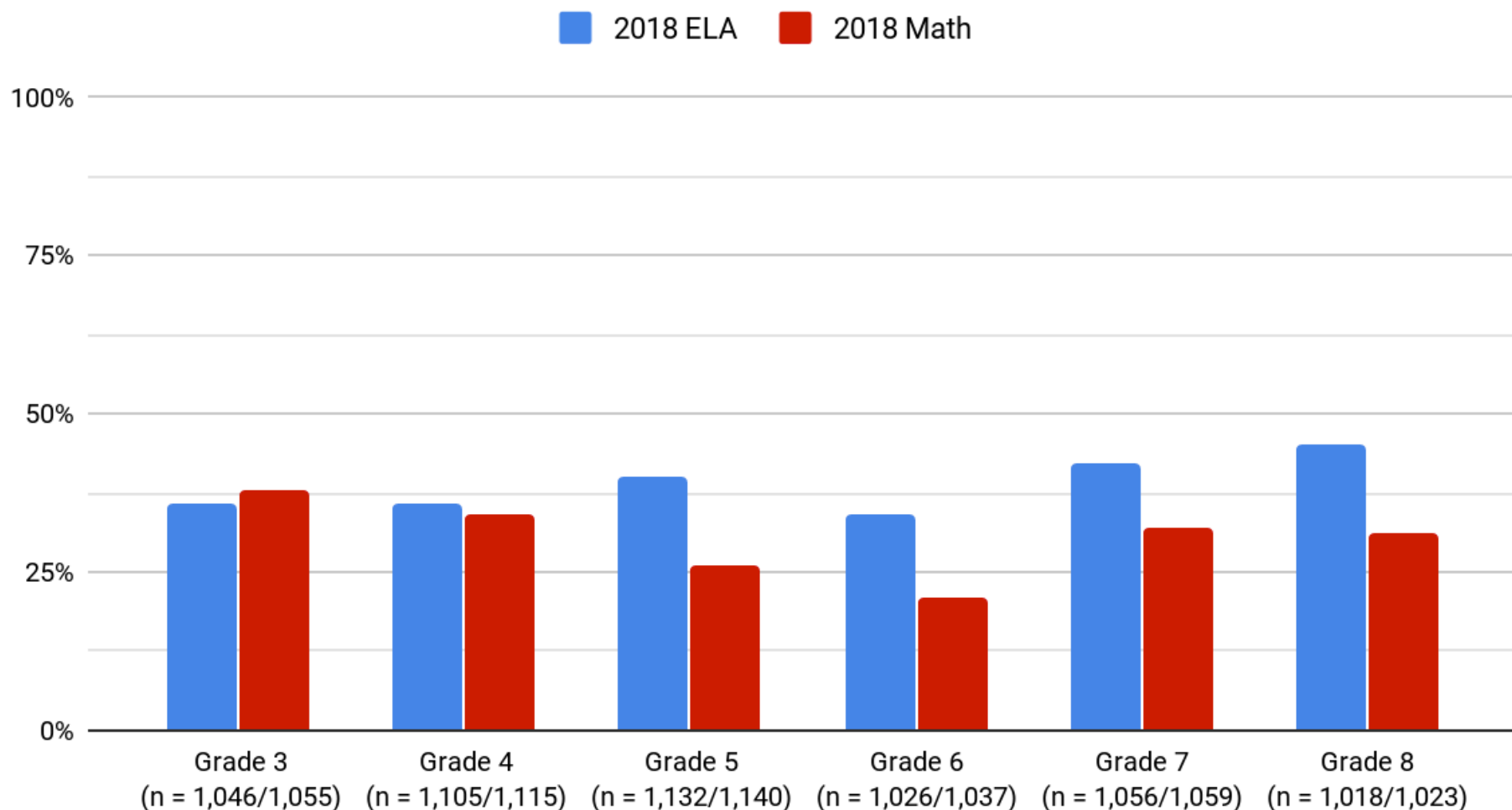
ARUSD English Language Arts - Met or Exceeded Standard by Ethnicity





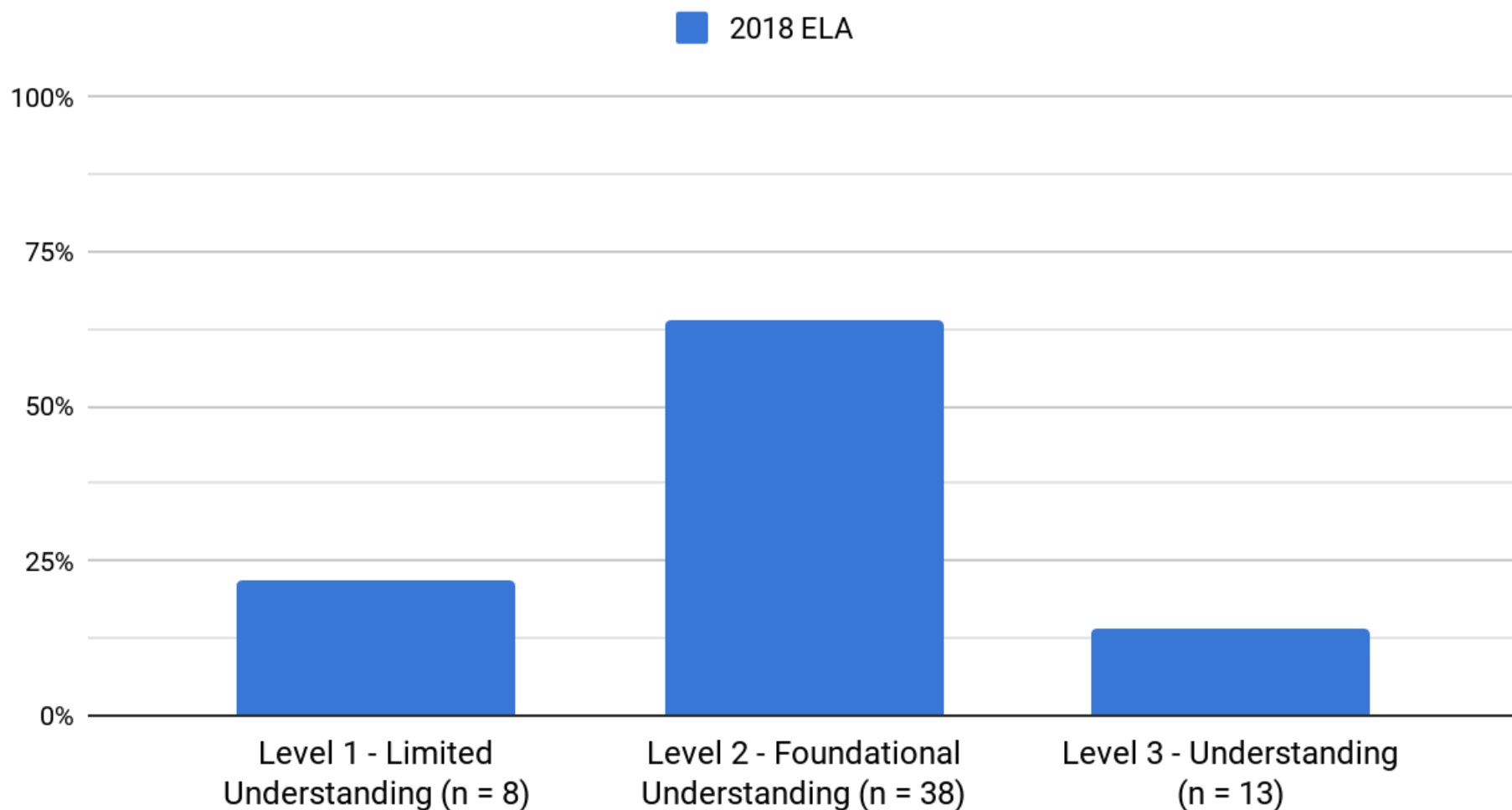
Grade Level Comparison

ELA and Mathematics - Met/Exceeded Standard by Grade

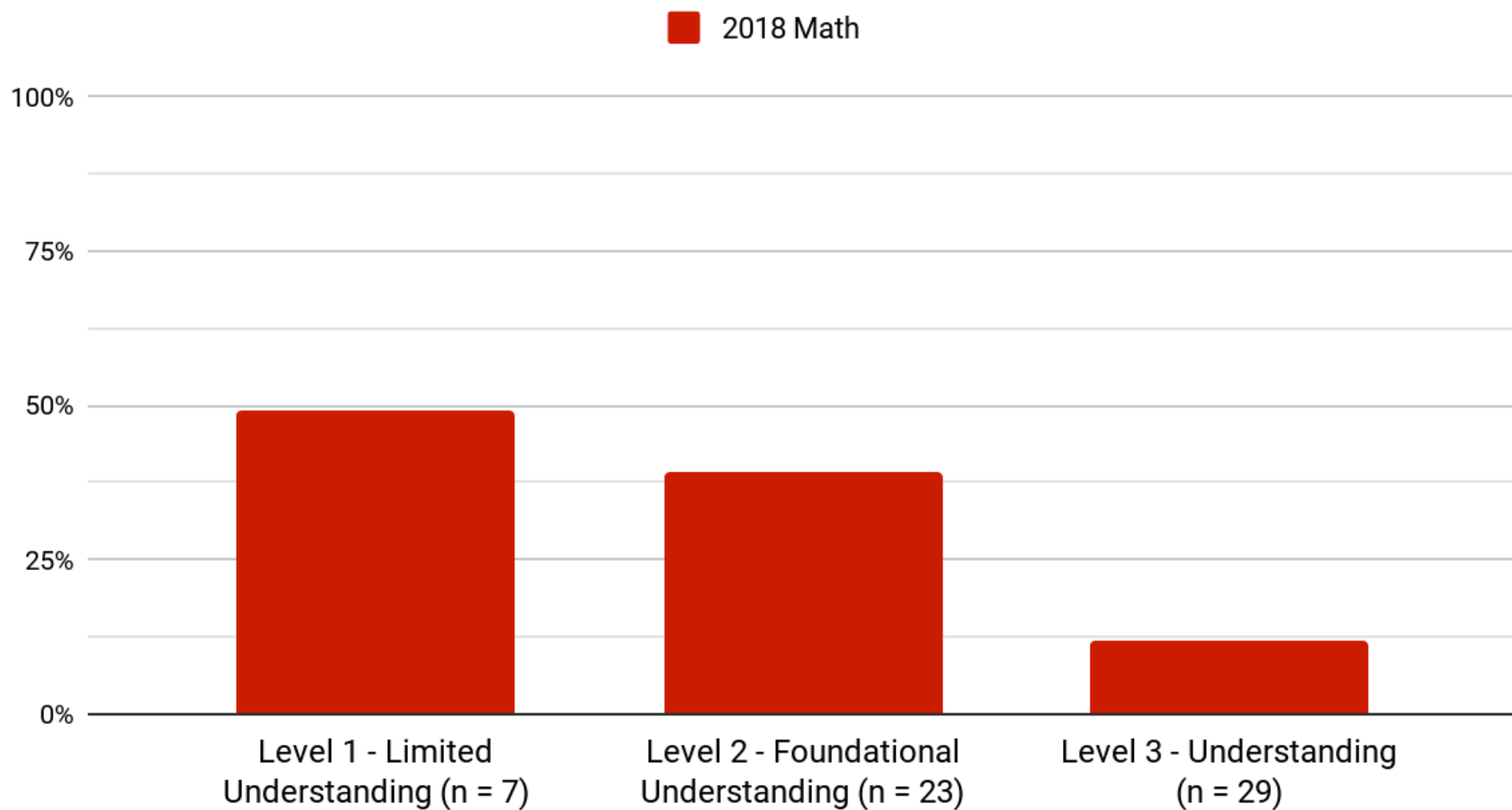
