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# Details of the Grant

- ❖ One time grant
  - ❖ Timeframe: March 2019 - November 2021
  - ❖ Serves students currently in 4th - 8th grade
  - ❖ Grant serves students identified as **low-performing** on state **English language arts or mathematics assessments (based on Smarter Balanced Spring 2019)**
    - *Not otherwise identified for supplemental grant funding under the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)*
    - *Not eligible for special education services*
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# Requirements of the Grant

- ❖ Create a plan describing how the funds will provide support for identified pupils
- ❖ Plan must be approved by Local Governing Board
- ❖ Submit first report by March 1, 2019
- ❖ Last report due in November 2021
