
Our Students

- 30+ days of professional development




Unique Teacher Training

- Created the Teaching Fellow Program
- Fellows spend 1 year shadowing a master Prize teacher
- Currently have four former fellows employed as full time teachers

SBAC % of Students Meeting or Exceeding Standards Over Time



English Learners: *Making Strides*




English Learner Progress in CA School Dashboard

Since 2015, our % of English Learners meeting or exceeding standards on SBAC has increased...

- ★ +19 percentage points on ELA
- ★ +12 percentage points in Math


