



Things Above from Fr. Bilot



BLESSINGS TO OUR FATHERS!

As a nation, we celebrate the gift of fatherhood. How wonderful that Father's Day also falls on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! We celebrate the great gift of God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three persons in one nature. All three work in one action throughout all of creation. We are

individual people, but what we do, in word or action, affects the Body of Christ. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit never work in isolation or for themselves. All their actions are done in love -- self-giving for the good of the other, for the good of all creation.

In celebrating Father's Day, I would like to look at the role of the "father." I believe a father should model his life from that of the Holy Trinity. A father needs to be a protector, a provider (not just materially, but physically, emotionally and mentally), and a spiritual warrior for the family. When a couple gets married, they promise to be faithful to each other, to honor and respect one another, and to raise their children in the Catholic faith. These promises are made at the wedding. For better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness or in health, the husband/father becomes an example of the Heavenly Father's love for all of His children.

A good and provident father models for his children, especially his sons, the love of the heavenly Father. For this Father's Day, here are some thoughts about fathers to help be the best man and father they can be.

First, I believe a father needs to be a great husband. The vows taken at marriage are important, because they mirror the love of Jesus Christ for the Church. Sacrifice, honor, love and service show a respect for the Sacrament of Marriage.

As I mentioned above, a father needs to be a spiritual warrior. Children need to see their dads praying - at home, at Mass, at dinner or a restaurant, and during daily activities. Dads can model the love of Jesus by frequently going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and bringing their children with them. Availing oneself to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Holy Eucharist lets your wife and your children know that you are not perfect, and you need God's mercy to help you grow in holiness and help the family be a "holy family."

Finally, dad needs to be the protector. In other words, be attentive to the needs of the family and be present to each family member. I know this idea may be daunting. However, if the Lord has called you to be a husband and father, he will equip you with the tools you need to be a protector, provider and spiritual warrior.

Finally, as we celebrate Father's Day, drawing on the Love of God our Father, I would strongly recommend the men of the parish (high school age and up) to join our Knights of Columbus Council here at Divine Child. The Grand Knight, Mr. Dominic Raona, is very attuned to the

Mission of the Knights (which is an international organization) and is continuing to implement prayer, service and fraternity to help men be the saints of tomorrow. Please see page twelve for contact information (or see me or Fr. Matt for more details).

Continue to pray for me, for Fr. Bob McCabe, and for Divine Child Parish as we continue to move forward in this time of transition. My last day will be Sunday, June 30. I am confident, with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, that through any difficulties, "all will be well." (Julian of Norwich, Mystic).

Corpus Christi Procession



The past few years, we have had the privilege to have a procession of the Blessed Sacrament on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. The feast of Corpus Christi, officially called "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ," is such a powerful moment in our life as a parish to proclaim the importance and power of the Eucharist in our lives. The Eucharist is the "source

and summit" of the Christian life. All our life as Christians finds its origin in the nourishment that we receive from the Eucharist and the celebration of the Eucharist is the highest point and summit of our lives from which we are sent forth on mission.


There are plenty of beautiful images of Eucharistic processions throughout the ages which show the devotion to the Eucharist throughout the ages. The image of Jules Breton, the 19th century French artist, captures beauty of a community gathered around Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The painting, "The Blessing of Wheat in Artois" (1857), shows a rural community with the peasants, laborers, children, and dignitaries all in procession to witness to their faith and ask for God's blessing on their fields. As the procession passes by, recognizing the presence of Christ, onlookers fall to their knees in adoration.



For our own community, may we have the same devotion and reverence as we prepare for our own Eucharistic procession next week. I invite you all to join us for the procession which will begin immediately following the 12:30 Mass on Sunday, June $23^{\rm rd}$.

Happy Father's Day! Knights can make good Dads too!

A quick search on Amazon and you can find thousands upon thousands of books on parenting. When we have children, we never go into it telling ourselves that we are going to be awful parents. Something from within calls us and gives us the will and want to strive to be a good parent. Reading all those parenting books will not guarantee you will glean the best parenting skills. In actuality, one book is likely to contradict the next, making you second guess everything you read and then leaving you no farther ahead than you were before you began reading! Our Catholic faith offers model parents in Mary and Joseph (granted the children we raise are not Divine Children), but yet we have holy people to look to and pray to for intercession to help us on our journey.

The role of father is more important now than ever before. Although we must continue to strive to be good fathers, we have to remember that by simply being in our children's lives is giving them so much more than many kids have. As father, our responsibility is to our wife and children. It is our job to teach right from wrong, our job to instill work ethic, our job to show and build character, and most importantly, our job to pass on our Catholic faith to our children (which means, we better have a pretty good handle on it our self!). Did you know that children who go to Mass with both parents have a 70% likelihood to continue going to Mass as an adult vs. children who only go to Mass with their mother have a 30% likelihood to continue going to Mass? It is true, our children are watching us. It is so important to start young and stay consistent. Children who see their father praying or sharing his faith with them may at first roll their eyes, but if you show them the way, it will begin to resonate!

Just like there is no perfect child, there is no perfect father. We are all flawed and have likely found ourselves second guessing the ways we handled situations with our children. The good news is most kids are very forgiving! It is ok to admit to your child that you made a mistake and discuss how things could have or might have gone differently. They will see the human side of you and together you will grow closer.






