School Board Meeting Summaries



At the May 28, 2019 Board of Education meeting the School Board:

- Recognized and honored our teachers retiring this year. Collectively they represent about 430 years of service to our district.
- Recognized our Future Business Leaders of America group that is going to state.
- Heard from Horizon students, teachers and principal about their Annual Arts and Activities Night.
- Heard from Anatomy and Physiology I students who created a website helping people with Community Healthcare.
- Approved the monitoring report for Operational Expectation 11 - Instructional Programs.
- Approved the monitoring report for Operational Expectation 9 - Communicating with the Public
- Approved the monitoring report for Operational Expectation 8 - Communicating with the School Board
- Heard a presentation from Baird and PMA regarding the issuance of the bonds for our referendum. This will come back to us in the form of a resolution at our next board meeting for approval.
- Heard from Phil Frei about the fixed items in our budget that are determined by the state and enrollment, etc. At our next meeting, we will hear some more information on budget items that the district is controlling.
- Approved a new policy and procedure relating to Family and Parent Engagement within the district.
- Approved a boundary change for the currently being constructed Catalyst apartments on Main St. These apartments will now fall into the Northside attendance area.
- Approved our continued participation in the Wisconsin School Nutrition Purchasing Cooperative.
- Discussed and approved a process for Community Involvement in the Design of Shared Use Spaces.
- Approved our 2019-2020 School Board Meeting Schedule and our new School Board Liaison positions.
- Discussed the happenings with the Wisconsin Legislature. Bryn Horton attended the meeting of the Joint Finance Committee when they passed their version of the Education budget. A letter was sent to the committee regarding the funding of the special education reimbursement with our resolution that we passed in August 2018 attached. Bryn will also be testifying about a lunch bill on Thursday.
