Senior Options for 2017-2018

- 1) Early College Program: Students will take a minimum of 15 credits at County College of Morris second semester of senior year and will receive high school and college credit. They will do option II for PE and document it through a signed journal. They will return to MHS for one block per week for a seminar. Students will receive ½ year credit for full year courses they took in the fall and grades will be frozen at the mid-year point. They must get written permission from the colleges to which they are applying. Applications will be available on the high school web site and there will be a meeting for interested students in the fall.
- 2) Afternoon Employment Option: Seniors may be scheduled for two morning classes each day and will be released at 10:45 a.m. each day to attend paid work.
- 3) Leave Early: Seniors who have met graduation requirements may take less than 40 credits. Their schedules will be adjusted that any free periods would occur at the end of the school day. Leave Early is only in effect for Block 4A or 4B or both and will be entered on their schedule. There will be no late arrivals.

4)	Career Inter	<u>nships</u>	(Full Day/5	Weeks):
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All seniors will have the option of ending their classes after the end of AP exams (3 week of May). They will submit an application detailing a career internship that is unpaid, is supervised by an adult other than their parent and is connected to a potential career interest. Students will complete a daily log and a final presentation. Applications will be available the spring of the student's senior year.
