Semester in Spain
Credit Transfer Agreement

This articulation agreement, which is effective on the date of the final signature, provides "Semester Abroad" opportunities for **Fisher College** students who are academically qualified and are interested in completing a semester at **The College for International Studies (CIS)** in Madrid, Spain. Students will complete between 12 and 15 transferrable credits at CIS after completing a minimum of 60 credits in their degree program at Fisher College.

Terms of Agreement:

1. **Fisher College** students accepted to this opportunity will attend full time classes at **The College of International Studies** campus in Madrid Spain for one semester. Students must be currently enrolled, in good standing, at Fisher College in either the Bachelor of Science in Management or the Bachelor of Arts in Communication and Media Studies degree programs. Students will receive up to 15 transferable academic credits for all college level courses that were successfully completed with a letter grade of [C-] or better with CIS.
2. The accompanying degree equivalency table for this Bachelor of Science in Management, and/or Bachelor of Arts in Communication & Media Studies articulation, shall determine transferrable courses for the respective programs, and shall be agreed upon prior to the student registration for their semester abroad.
3. Students must qualify for this "semester abroad" program *at least* three months prior to the start of their intended experience in Spain. Students must:

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
- a. Complete a minimum of two full time semesters of academic work at Fisher College
 - b. Have obtained a a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
 - c. Complete all pre-requisite courses required for coursework at CIS
 - d. Apply and be accepted through the Dean's office at Fisher College
 - e. Proficiency in the Spanish language is desired but it is not a requirement
 - f. Complete all application requirements for CIS
 - g. Demonstrate a financial ability to travel and support this semester in Spain
 - h. Possess, or actively pursue, a passport and/or VISA for this experience
4. This agreement will be reviewed annually and may be revised by mutual consent. In addition, CIS and Fisher College agree to notify one another of program changes that might affect the transfer of courses under this agreement.
 5. Both colleges agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising for the purpose of marketing this Semester Abroad program, described herein. All materials must be approved by the respective communications and/or marketing offices at the partner college.
 6. **Fisher College** agrees to provide to **The College for International Studies**, student information for the express purpose of contacting Fisher students directly regarding the Semester Abroad program between the two institutions described in this Articulation Agreement in compliance with all state and federal laws.

Fisher College and **The College for International Studies**, recognizing the importance of providing a seamless coordination between the respective colleges, hereby enter into an Articulation Agreement.




