





## Articulation Agreement

*Between First Response EME / Canton Fire Consortium for EMS Education & Fisher College*

1. Fisher College assures the acceptance of up to 18-credits from the First Response EME / Canton Fire Consortium for EMS Education program as outlined in the transfer table below. Proof of successful completion of the courses outlined in the First Response EME / Canton Fire Consortium for EMS Education program must be provided to Fisher College by each student in the form of an official transcript.
2. Transfer students will receive academic credit and the credit will be applied to either an associate degree or bachelor degree.
3. The Fisher College catalog contains all information about the degree requirements. Students wishing to plan their degree program to meet prerequisites for upper level courses are encouraged to communicate early with an admissions counselor at Fisher College to secure specific information about their transfer credits.
4. This agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and may be revised by mutual agreement.
5. Both colleges agree to the right to use each other's names in print materials and media advertising. All materials must be approved by the respective communications and/or marketing offices at the partner college.
6. This notice is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with not less than one year's notice.
