




## Articulation Agreement

### Introduction


This Articulation Agreement is between Smart Horizons and Fisher College to establish a partnership in which Fisher College will provide access to credit-based, educational opportunities to students of Smart Horizons.

### Terms of the Agreement:


1. Fisher College will accept up to a maximum of 120 clock hours from Smart Horizons students. Every 20 clock-hours completed will be equivalent to one (1) elective credit which allows up to a maximum of six (6) transfer elective credits into our Bachelor of Human Service program with an Early Childhood/Early Intervention concentration and if transferring into our Associates Degree in Early Childhood a maximum of (3) transfer elective credits will be awarded.
2. Non-credit or remedial courses adjudged to be below college level may not be accepted for transfer.
3. It is understood that if a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper level course because he/she has not taken introductory courses, he/she will be required to take the necessary prerequisite(s). Therefore, Fisher College cannot assure every student the completion of requirements for the bachelor degree.
4. The Fisher College catalog contains all information about the degree requirements. Students wishing to plan their bachelor degree program to ensure meeting prerequisites for upper level courses are encouraged to communicate early with an admissions counselor at Fisher College to secure specific information about their transfer credits.
5. This agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and may be revised by mutual agreement.
6. This agreement grants permission for both parties to provide an Internet link to each organization's website and grants authorized use of branded logo for the purpose of promoting the affiliation. Prior written approval will be obtained before any party's logo is used to promote the affiliation for any other purpose.
7. This agreement is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with not less than one year's notice.
8. Notwithstanding the foregoing, those students who begin coursework at Smart Horizons while this Agreement is active shall be entitled to the benefits of this Agreement upon application for articulation with Fisher College.
