**Recommended Items** – These are items which students use in class.

**Young Fives**

**Recommended:**

2 boxes of Kleenex  
4 large glue sticks  
(2) 4 packs of playdough (any colors)

**Label the following with your child's name:**

1 backpack or school bag (no wheels)  
1 zippered pencil bag (no plastic boxes)  
1 pair of headphones for computers (no earbuds)  
4 boxes of 8 crayons (not jumbo size please)  
1 box of washable markers  
4 large black dry erase markers  
Shoobox/Ziploc bag with complete change of clothes in case of accidents. (Please remember to switch these out for the seasons or when needed.)

**Donations:**

Stickers, small puzzles, zip lock bags, popsicle sticks, q-tips, cotton balls, and general arts & craft supplies (glitter, pom-poms, pipe cleaners, googly eyes, buttons, etc.)

**Kindergarten**

***Do NOT label ANY materials Kindergarten students are learning to share. THANKS for your cooperation!***

**Recommended:**

1 backpack or school bag (*no wheels - can be labeled with name*)  
4 large glue sticks  
(3) 4 packs of Expo small/skinny dry erase markers or pack of 12  
2 LARGE pink erasers  
1 plastic folder with pockets & clasps  
1 plastic folder with pockets only

2 boxes of Crayola crayons (no more than 24)  
1 coloring book for indoor recess  
1 box of Kleenex  
1 pump of hand sanitizer  
1 box (2 pack) Mr. Clean Magic Erasers

**BOYS BRING:**

*1 baby wipe container*

**Snacks:**

Rather than sending in an individual snack daily, we ask each family to send in a snack for the whole class to share once a month. **Snacks must be healthy for growing minds and bodies.** Individually wrapped portions are easiest for us to pass out to the class. Some good suggestions are Granola or Cereal Bars, crackers like Cheez-its or goldfish, pretzels, pudding cups, applesauce or fruit cups. Fresh fruit like bananas, apples, tangerines, and grapes are also very welcome. *Chips, cookies, or other high-sugar foods are NOT considered to be healthy for everyday snacks.*

**Grade One**

**Recommended:**

**Recommended:**

1 "Composition" notebook  
package of dry erase markers (Expo Chisel Tip work best)  
1 container of disinfecting wipes

washable markers  
1 small pencil box/bag  
10 Glue sticks (no liquid glue)  
crayons  
scissors (Fiskars work best)  
1 large box of Kleenex  
1 box gallon size Ziploc bags (no sliders)

4 spiral bound notebooks (70 pages, wide-ruled)
