The Opportunity

The Position

Tilton School seeks an experienced and energetic Science teacher (biology, chemistry, physics) with a passion for developing student skills in critical thinking, communication, creative engagement and design thinking. Successful candidates will be committed to their own professional growth, able to teach students of a wide range of ages and ability levels and eager to work with colleagues on the future of high school science to implement the best practices while also exploring innovative strategies. The position includes teaching four or five classes under the supervision of the Science Department Chair.

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate

- Outstanding skills in oral and written communication
- An abiding belief that all students can grow and succeed in a rigorous science curriculum
- Experience with Design-Thinking and Problem-Based Learning
- Expertise in the integration of technology into classroom instruction
- Ability to work well in a student-centered curriculum
- Understanding of learning styles and differentiated instruction
- An eagerness to work in an intense, changing and supportive learning community

Applicants must be able to attend a week-long 1st Year Faculty Workshop in early August. Other duties include: (1) advising, (2) participation as an athletic coach or activities leader for two seasons each year and (3) active participation in our residential program, including weeknight-weekend supervision.
