##### Scholarships for Transfer Students

St. Francis College awards transfer scholarships to eligible students ranging from \$6,000 to \$12,000. Eligibility is based on the overall academic grade point average (GPA) from all prior colleges attended.

Scholarships may be used to defray full-time tuition costs for fall and spring semesters only and are renewable annually as long as the appropriate GPA is maintained. Many students also receive federal and state aid and loans to help pay for the difference in tuition and fees that are not covered by institutional scholarship.

### **2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:**



### **3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:**


- This articulation agreement will be publicized on the St. Paul's School of Nursing and St. Francis College's websites.




