Legislative Update

Ms. Scodro also gave an update on the state's legislative session. She informed the board that the spring session concluded on June 1 and there were no last minute amendments that concerned the district.

An increase in educational spending passed, but it is unlikely for Palos 118 to benefit due to its Tier 4 status. Also passed was a mandatory increase in minimum teacher salary for 2023.

The property tax freeze and consolidation bill did not pass, but Ms. Scodro plans on meeting with representatives Kelly Burke and Bill Cunningham this summer to discuss.
