Dear CHS Precalculus I and II Student,

Since you are entering a college level class in the fall of 2019, you will want to keep your mathematical skills sharp over the summer. Therefore North Creek High School has constructed some review assignments for you to complete over the summer weeks. There are a total of ten review assignments that will be assigned once per week over the summer. Then upon returning to school in the fall, there will be 3 additional assignments for you to complete during the first three weeks of the school year. All 13 assignments are required to be completed by September 30, 2019.

You will find all of these assignments on WAMAP (Washington Mathematics Assessment and Placement). The instructions for registering for these assignments is attached to this letter.

Your CHS Precalculus I and II teacher will have access to your progress and scores through the WAMAP system. **Your teacher will be collecting your work so you must remember to copy the problem, show your complete work in a clear and organized manner.** Again, these assignments must be completed online by September 30, 2019. Due to the volume of work, it is suggested that you work on this throughout the summer, not just in September!

Should you need assistance with this work, all concepts may be found in Algebra 2 or Algebra 2/Trig curriculum that you recently completed and thus that textbook will be a valuable resource. Reminder you may access the online textbook by going to:

Your second step is to register for the correct summer class (see attached).

**Important Information: College in the High School classes through Cascadia College.**

You will enroll in the CHS class once the school year has begun so clear and complete information will be provided at that time.

**Qualifying for CHS Precalculus I and II Classes:** You are automatically qualified to register for the CHS class if your Algebra 2 or Algebra 2/Trig Second Semester grade is a B or above (B- is not sufficient).

If your Algebra 2 or Algebra 2/Trig Second Semester grade is less than a B, you are required to take and pass the Accuplacer at Cascadia (<http://www.cascadia.edu/apply/accuplacer.aspx>). Suggestion: If you are required to take the Accuplacer do it as soon as possible as your math skills are currently at an all time high...you just finished the school year. Most student's math skills normally do not improve over the summer!
