

Parents/Guardians,

The date of immunizations or illness (ex: Chickenpox) must be on file with the school nurse prior to school entry.

Washington State's School Immunization Law [RCW 28A.210.080](#) requires documentation of immunization at the time of school registration. A completed Certificate of Immunization (CIS) signed by the parent/guardian **must be on file at the school on or before the student's first day at school**. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to obtain the required documentation, complete the form AND turn it in to the school before the student can start school.

Please fill out the CIS completely, sign in the appropriate boxes and attach a copy of your healthcare provider verified record of immunization with the CIS.
