We have been contacted a number of times in the past week to be told that parents have parked across or even IN driveways, preventing our neighbours from leaving their house. We urge you to be good-mannered and role

models to your children and park in a safe and courteous way.

Similarly, please avoid the yellow zig-zags outside the school as staff are unable to see traffic from either direction when exiting the school car park. Please also avoid parking directly opposite the school gates.

Highway Code Rule 243, you should not park near a school entrance as well as anywhere that would prevent access for emergency services, at or near a bus stop, opposite or within 10 metres of a junction, over a dropped kerb, and in front of an entrance to a property.
