RE: Hamilton Avenue School – Grass Field Project

To the Hamilton Avenue School Students, Parents, Staff and Neighbors,

As part of the process for the Hamilton Avenue School Grass Field Project, the design team from Milone & MacBroom met with the Town of Greenwich Planning & Zoning Department who approved the submitted Drainage Summary Report with revisions. Those revisions included a review of the area directly adjacent to the existing basketball court for the possible installation of a storm water retention system. The review will consist of digging several test pits of up to 4 ft deep to determine if the existing soils are capable of providing drainage from the impervious surfaces.

We have scheduled the work to take place over the Spring Break with contractors on site Monday 15 April (weather permitting) and hope to have the excavation and backfilling of these test pits completed no later than Friday the 19th. The work has been scheduled over the vacation break as to create as little impact on student programming as possible. Once the backfilling has been completed the areas will remain fenced off to allow for the grass seed to germinate

We are excited to be progressing this work and look forward to the completion of the overall Hamilton Field Project.
