Safe Routes Utah Syracuse Junior High School 2019-2020

Our mission is to find the safest routes for our students, to and from Syracuse Junior High School. **School Location**: Syracuse Junior High School- 1450 South 2000 West, Syracuse, Utah.

EXISTING TRAFFIC CONTROLS

- 1. Traffic light at 1000 West and 1700 South.
- 2. Traffic light at 1475 W. (Marilyn Dr.) and 1700 South.
- 3. Traffic light at 2000 West and 1700 South.
- 4. Traffic light at 3000 West and 1700 South.
- 5. Traffic light at 2000 West and 700 South.
- 6. **HAWK** signal (High-Intensity Activated crossWalK beacon) across 2000 West between the Jr. High and Syracuse Elementary School for pedestrian safety.

ESTABLISHED SCHOOL ZONES

School Crosswalk Zones

- 1475 West (Marilyn Dr.) and 1700 South; two Crossing Guards present before school at 7:45 and after school from 3:15-4:00.
- 2000 West and 1700 South; three Crossing Guards present before school at 7:30 and after school until 3:50.
- 2000 West between Syracuse Jr. High and Syracuse Elementary; two Crossing Guards present before school at 7:30 and after school until 3:50.
- Bluff Road and 1700 South; one crossing guard present before school at 7:30 and after school from 3:05-3:35 crossing only east and west across Bluff Rd.
- 3000 West and 1700 South; one crossing guard present before school at 7:30 and after school from 3:05-4:00.
- Doral Drive and 1700 South; one crossing guard present before school at 7:40 and after school from 3:15-4:00.
- Banbury Drive and 700 South; one crossing guard present before school at 7:40 and after school from 3:30-4:00.
- 1290 South 1100 West; one crossing guard present after school from 3:20-3:45.
- 1350 South 1100 West; one crossing guard present after school from 3:20-3:45.
- 1250 West 1350 South; one crossing guard present after school from 3:20-3:45.

School Bus Loading Zone

• School buses enter the school at the north end of the school property. The buses turn south and park in a double row, parallel to the sidewalk in the north sector of the school parking lot.

PARKING AREAS AND STUDENT DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Parking Areas

- The parking lot on the south side of the school is intended to accommodate parents and guests.
- The parking lot in front of the school is intended for faculty and staff only.
- The front red curb is for police and emergency vehicles only; it is not a parking area.
- No parking on 2000 West within 30 feet of entrances, exits and crosswalks.

Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up

• Student drop-off and pick-up is available at the south door. Parents may enter on the south side of the school, just east of the Seminary building, and drop-off/pick-up students at the south door then drive around the parking lot and exit where they entered.

• Student drop off and pick up is available at the front door. Parents may enter on the south side of the school, just east of the Seminary building, turn right in front of the school, drop-off/pick-up students at the front door and then exit in front of the school.

HAZARD/FOOTNOTE

No sidewalk available

- Along Bluff Road from 1700 South to 3000 West: There is no sidewalk, but there is a wide shoulder on east side.
- There is no sidewalk on the north side of 1700 South between 2500 West and Doral Drive.

2000 West hazards

• If parents choose to drop-off/pick-up on 2000 West in front of the school, they should avoid parking within 30 feet of entrances and exits. Students should not cross 2000 West except at the crosswalk. Students should not cross in front of and between cars and buses.

WALKING ROUTES

Quadrant I (North West)

Students living between 2000 West and 2500 West, and between 700 South and 1500 South will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 2200 West and travel on the east side to 1275 South, turn east to 2000 West and turn south to Syracuse Junior High School. Or, students continue south to 1425 South to access the catwalk to the school through back playing fields.

Students living between 1150 South and 1700 South, and between 2500 West and Bluff Road will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 1200 South, then go east to 2500 West, cross at the crosswalk, then travel south to 1425 South, then straight east to access the catwalk to the school through back playing fields.

Students living between 2000 West and 3000 West, and between 400 South and 700 South will:

• Travel south on the east side of 2925 West to 700 South, then go east on the north side of 700 South to 2500 West. Cross at the crosswalk on 700 South and travel on the east sidewalk to 1175 South, turn east and travel on the north side to 2200 West. Then travel on the east side to 1275 South and turn east to 2000 West. Turn south to Syracuse Junior High School.

Students living between 3000 West and St Andrews Drive and between 900 South and 1700 South will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 3000 West. Travel north on the west side of 3000 West and cross 3000 West using the crosswalk north of Bluff Road. Travel on the east side of 3000 West to 1200 South. Turn east and travel on the south side of 1200 South to 2500 West, cross at the crosswalk, then travel south to 1425 South, then straight east to access the catwalk to the school through back playing fields.

Quadrant II (North East)

Students living between Highway 193 and 700 South, and between 1550 West and 1350 West will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to the west side of 1525 West and 700 South. Cross at crosswalk on 700 South and then travel along the west side of 1525 West to Dallas Street. Turn west and travel on the north side to 1925 West then turn south and travel on the east side to

1350 South following the sidewalk to 2000 West. Then travel the east sidewalk on 2000 West to the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.

Students living between 700 South and 1700 South, and between 1000 West and 1525 West will:

- Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 1525 West and Dallas Street. Turn west and travel on the north side of Dallas Street to 1925 West then turn south and travel on the east side to 1350 South following the sidewalk to 2000 West. Then travel the east sidewalk on 2000 West until the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.
- Students can also travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 1700 South. Turn west and travel on the north sidewalk to 2000 West, then continue on the east sidewalk to the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.

Students living between 700 South and 1700 South, and between 1525 West and 2000 West will:

- Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to Banbury Drive and Dallas Street. Turn west and travel on the north side to 1925 West then turn south and travel on the east side to 1350 South following the sidewalk to 2000 West. Then travel the east sidewalk on 2000 West until the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.
- Students can also travel internal subdivision sidewalks to Banbury Drive and 1500 South. Cross at the crosswalks to Founders Park and using the sidewalks around Syracuse Elementary travel to the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.

Students living east of 1000 West will:

• Travel on the east side of 1000 West and cross 1000 West at either the crosswalk at 1290 South, or at the intersection at 1700 South. Then travel west to 2000 West crossing at either the crosswalk at 1700 South or at the HAWK signal.

Quadrant III (South East)

Students living between 1700 South and 2700 South, and between Allison Way and 2000 West will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 2000 West. Head north on the east side of 2000 West to 1700 South. Cross 1700 South using the crosswalks at the intersection, then continue on the east sidewalk to the HAWK signal. Cross 2000 West at the HAWK signal to Syracuse Junior High School.

Quadrant IV (South West)

Students living between 1700 South and 2700 South and between 2000 West and Bluff Road will:

- Travel internal subdivision sidewalks east to 2000 West. Head north on the west side of 2000 West to 1700 South. Cross 1700 South using the crosswalks the intersection, then continue on the west sidewalk to Syracuse Jr. High School.
- Students can also travel north to 1900 South then head east on the north sidewalk to 2000 West. Head north on the west side of 2000 West to 1700 South. Cross 1700 South using the crosswalks at the intersection, then continue on the west sidewalk to Syracuse Jr. High School.

Students living between 1700 South and 2495 South and between Bluff Road and 3000 West will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 3000 West. Head north on the east side of 3000 West to 1700 South. Travel east on the south side of 1700 South to 2000 West. Cross 1700 South using the crosswalks at the intersection, then continue on the west sidewalk to Syracuse Jr. High School.

Students living between 1700 South and 2400 South and between 3000 West and Doral Drive who do not ride the bus will:

• Travel internal subdivision sidewalks to 1700 South. Head east on the south side of 1700 South to 2000 West. Cross 1700 South using the crosswalks at the intersection, then continue on the west sidewalk to Syracuse Jr. High School.
