



The new NP homework guidelines for students grades 4-5 are a critical part of our school-wide effort to achieve the following goals:

1. An increase in purposeful reading and analysis of fiction, non-fiction, and informational text across content areas.
2. Students will practice their written communication through various forms, which could include responses to reading, analysis/evaluation of text or written pieces which reflect the varied genres of writing.
3. Nightly independent practice of mathematical concepts and procedures learned in class.
4. School-wide consistent homework expectations.
