We are pleased to announce that our Primary Student Council will be hosting our annual Primary Writing Event throughout the next academic year in association with British Schools in the Middle East. This is an online competition, which was launched in 2017, to provide students who attend schools in the Middle East with the opportunity to demonstrate their ideas and imagination through writing. It also offers students a platform to an international audience who will read and judge their work. In today's world, it is becoming increasingly important that young people are given the opportunity to express their ideas creatively. We hope that such creativity will be fostered through this event, giving aspiring young writers a chance to shine.

Our previous competitions, 'Dear Future Me' and 'Portal to the Pyramids' have encouraged students to get excited about writing and practising with different genres has broadened their overall writing experience. Most importantly, the feedback we have received from participating schools indicates that the activities provided have made writing fun and relevant for students of all ages.

The theme for next year's competition will be a diary entry entitled 'A Day in the Life of...' which we have purposefully left open-ended as we hope that schools can easily integrate this writing task into the curriculum in all year groups.

- Years 3 and 4
