HARASSMENT-INTIMIDATION-BULLYING

Harassment: persistently disturbing a student

Sexual Harassment: unwanted and uninvited sexual attention

Intimidation: making someone feel afraid through the force of one's personality or personal strength

Bullying: Intentional repeated negative acts (physical, emotional, verbal) by one person(s) towards

another

Harassment, intimidation or bullying will not be allowed. Harassment, intimidation or bullying means any intentional written, verbal, electronic or physical act, including, but not limited to one shown to be motivated by race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, any kind of mental or physical disability or other distinguishing characteristics** when the intentional written, verbal or physical act:

- Physically harms a student or damages the student's property or;
- Has the effect of substantially interfering with a student's education or;
- Is so severe, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating or threatening educational environment or;
- Does not require the affected student to actually possess a characteristic that is a basis for harassment or;
- Has the effect of substantially disrupting the ordering operation of the school

**Other distinguishing characteristics may include, but are not limited to: physical appearance, clothing or other apparel, socioeconomic status, gender identity and marital status. Harassment, intimidation or bullying can take many forms including: slurs, rumors, jokes, innuendos, demeaning comments, drawings, cartoons, pranks, gestures, physical attacks, threats or other written, verbal or physical actions.

The following discipline steps will be followed for any incident regarding harassment, intimidation or bullying. Each step includes policy review and clarification.

Date:	1 st Offense:	Verbal warning, incident documented
Date:	2 nd Offense:	Responsibility contract, one to three days detention, parent notification
Date:	3 rd Offense:	Short-term suspension, incident documented and parent notification
Date:	4 th Offense:	Long-term suspension, incident documented and parent notification
Date:	5 th Offense:	Expulsion, incident documented and parent notification
