Minutes from last month

- A motion was made by Cindy Nottingham to approve last month's minutes and it was seconded by Adrienne Kennett.

Update on Current Goals

○ District Goal #1: Literacy

- This year we did not meet the 3% increase. We are ahead of the district average, but were shy of reaching the goal. This might be due to the more than 3% goal that was met from the previous year. We have shown growth from the BOY to MOY this year. We have also had an 11% reduction in red students from last year.

○ District Goal #2:

- STEM and Math Professional Development – Teachers are participating in the SWIVL Cam project and Math Questioning Trainings. Many are taking 2-4 additional classes. We also recently purchased “coding” programs for prep classes.

○ District Goal #3:

- As of March 2018, we have had 186 office referrals, which is down 84 referrals from last year. We have done this by implementing Mindful

Schools, the HOPE squad, using exceptional student tickets and visual adult presence within the school.

- Adrienne attended “Playworks”.org (structured recess) to observe the program working in another school. This program teaches students how to play fairly, “Games of the Week”, Upper grades are used as peer coaches for games, Vanessa said our school can only spend \$5,000.00 on character development. The rest of \$12,000.00 cost needs to come from a different source.

□ Proposed Goals for 2018-2019 & Teacher Feedback

- Math Goal – Continue professional development
- DIBELS (reading) – Increase benchmark percentage by 2-3% and keep the grades 4-6 component
- Technology – Use \$60,000.00 over the next 4 years to go one on one on computers, Ipads and laptops (district funded)
