TRANSPORTATION

If you have chosen to avail yourself of the transportation services during ESY, you will be contacted by the district's transportation department regarding your child's times of bus pick up and drop off. If you are picking up or dropping off your child, please proceed to the front entrance of BRHS. Parents dropping off or picking up students will not be reporting directly to the classroom. Teachers and instructional assistants will meet students at the door to facilitate the movement of students to and from classrooms so we can minimize interruptions to instructional sessions. If your child is scheduled to attend a camp before or after their ESY session please complete and return form 3710-R (attached to email). **This form should be submitted no later than Friday, June 7, 2019 to sfilep@brrsd.org or faxed to Shana at Adamsville School 908-725-0610.**

ATTENDANCE

Staff will be detailing student attendance. If your child will be absent from the program please contact the High School at 908-231-8660 and ask for the ESY office to report this information to staff.

MEDICAL

It is extremely important that the Emergency Medical form be submitted prior to the first day of the program. Any student without a completed emergency medical form will not be permitted to attend the program until the form has been submitted online or been received by a member of the ESY staff. The ESY program will NOT provide food. Students attending **4** hours of programming should bring a packed snack or lunch each day.
