### **WORKSHOP TOPIC**

Dr. Amy Dudley, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment presented the workshop topic, "Social-Emotional Learning." The presentation explained the importance of incorporating social-emotional learning in the classroom and effective practices to embed throughout the school day. During the workshop, board members practiced techniques of mindfulness, participated in an exercise called "Community Circle" and learned about "Zones of Regulation." #### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Beresford congratulated the CHS DECA Team on a successful state competition! 293 CHS students participated in the state competition and 111 students qualified for the International DECA Conference in Orlando.
- Dr. Beresford congratulated the CHS WHJE radio team for earning 16 national awards at the Intercollegiate Broadcasting Awards in New York City. He shared that 30 students also earned runner-ups in their respective categories.
- Dr. Beresford shared with the Board that he attended Orchard Park Elementary's biggest fundraiser of the year, Taste of Carmel. He commended the PTO and volunteers for planning a well-organized and successful event. He mentioned it was wonderful to see all the support Orchard Park Elementary has within the community.
- Dr. Beresford stated that board members and administrators visited new elementary school construction sites to see next generation learning spaces. He shared that the district is continuing to focus on the design of the two new elementary schools.
- Dr. Beresford shared with the Board that the district received 282 nominations from the community for the 2019 CCS Teacher of the Year! A committee of teachers and administrators will begin to narrow the nominations down to 25 semi-finalists. One semi-finalist will be chosen from each elementary school, two semi-finalists will be chosen from each middle school and eight semi-finalists will be selected from the high school. The CCS Teacher of the Year will be announced in April 2019.
- Dr. Beresford shared with the Board that this week (March 11-15) is Food Service Staff Appreciation Week. He stated that our food service employees go above and beyond every day to make sure our kids have healthy school breakfasts and lunches.
- Dr. Beresford congratulated the CHS Culinary Team on earning a gold medal and Best Starter Award.
   He also reported that Baking and Pastry earned 1st place in the state competition and will be representing Indiana at FCCLA Nationals in July.
- Dr. Beresford congratulated Clay Middle School 8th grade student Harry Zheng who placed second among 221 competitors at the state competition of MATHCOUNTS. He will be competing at Nationals in Orlando in May.
