

STUDENT REPRESENTATION ON SCHOOL BOARD

I. AUTHORIZED STUDENT REPRESENTATION

- A. The School Board authorizes student representative(s) to serve as a non-voting member in order to encourage student involvement and provide a communication link between the School Board and the student body.
- B. The student representative(s) must be a current ROCORI High School Student Senate member determined by a student senate vote to serve a one-year term.

II. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE(S)

- A. The student representative(s) will be bound by all rules and regulations which bind the School Board within law.
- B. The student representative(s) will attend all regular School Board meetings and special meetings when appropriate while school is in session. If absenteeism becomes a problem, an alternate selected by the student senate and in consultation with the superintendent will take the student representative's place. The student representative(s) will not be permitted to attend closed meetings.
- C. The student representative(s) will have a designated seat at the board table and should report on any matters of interest to the School Board. The student representative(s) will not have the right to vote or to make or second motions.
- D. The student representative(s) should report to the student senate on all matters discussed at School Board meetings which pertain to the student body at the next meeting of the student senate.
- E. The student representative(s) will not be furnished with materials pertaining to confidential issues such as sensitive personnel matters, legal action strategy, negotiations strategy, individual student discipline, or other confidential matters.
