

Magnet and Neighborhood Transfer Information/Instructions for Summer Window

To apply for a transfer applications for the 2019-2020 school year, a parent/guardian **must submit the application online** at <u>tulsaschools.org/transfer</u>. For access to a computer or assistance, please visit the Tulsa Public Schools Enrollment Center.

Submit required documents for magnet schools	No later than July 17, 2019 by 4 pm			

Application Guidelines

- Students may apply for one magnet school and two neighborhood schools.
- You must submit online applications and required documents by the deadlines to be eligible for consideration. The online system will notify you via email when the application has been submitted. If you do not have access to email, please call 918-746-6138.
- Before we can process the application, you must submit required documents or deliverables. You can upload and attach the guardian's ID and proof of residency or hand deliver them to the Enrollment Center. All other documents must be delivered to the Enrollment Center no later than 4 pm on July 17, 2019.
- All applicants to a criteria based school must provide grades and attendance from both semesters of the 2017-2018 school year and the first semester of the 2018-2019 school year, as well as standardized test scores for math and reading from the Spring of 2018 and/or Fall of 2018.

Applicants should rank schools in order of preference. The district determines available spaces for transfers using capacity, forecast, and allocations. We use an electronic selection process to select students for each grade with space available. We will notify applicants by email whether they are approved for a transfer or if they are placed on a waiting list.
