FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

MOMENTUM: ENERGY, ENTHUSIASM AND EXPECTATION

It has been a year of excitement, in every way. While the phrase "business as usual" is often music to the ears of many, it just doesn't ring true here at Shelton, except in one way—we're always about our core mission, dedicated to making a difference by serving and empowering the lives of students who just happen to learn differently. We are not doing things as usual. We are engaged with change and forward-thinking action that will ensure we are here for future generations of

students. Now in our 43rd year, we're full throttle to relocate our educational home and resources to our new campus at 17301 Preston Road.



The dream of consolidating a Shelton educational experience onto a unified campus is coming true. After receiving zoning approval in August 2017, we are moving forward. Our architects continue to render and refine our plans



as we crystalize specific enhancements for transforming the experience of every Shelton student. The work of Board, faculty and staff, families and friends, and our students is coming to fruition, right before our eyes.

Academics First—the Student Experience

Academics always comes first. We'll be able to increase our classrooms from 105 to 125. This makes possible many more opportunities that are deemed essential in today's educational environment.

Such spaces will allow us to respond to the mandate of enhanced STEM curriculum. Everyone today clamors for rigor in science, technology, engineering and math. At our new campus, we'll expand from five to 12 hands-on science labs, have a robotics lab, and four dedicated STEM rooms.

Our curriculum offerings—including coding, programming, designing with the 3-D printer—have expanded dramatically, and we'll soon have the facilities to match. These are not luxuries or niceties—they are bona fide essentials for the world in which our graduates will live and work. City, state and national workforces demand an elevated emphasis on these disciplines and critical thinking skills, and Shelton will be better equipped to deliver in this arena. We'll also gain Makerspace for our libraries and various areas for collaboration. Educational designers believe these spaces enhance the creative exchanges, interactions and experiences of future entrepreneurs, problem-solvers and project managers.

ENTHUSIASM for the Whole Student via Fine Arts and Athletics

A major reason for our move is our desire to enhance what Shelton offers in fine arts and athletics. For some, these two extracurricular programs are what most excite and motivate our students to come to school each day. They are the sweet spots that allow our students to best express their strengths and creativity.

A new Fine Arts Center will be a boon in every way to our talented students and the community at large. We'll have a theater that holds 450, a black box for 200, band hall and choir room, scene shop, and studios for film, ceramics, sculpture and more. We'll have a lab for digital

photography and music. Countless hours currently spent to repeatedly repurpose make-shift class and performance spaces will be eliminated, resulting in hours redirected to creative engagement with students and a streamlined functionality for students and staff. Instead of showcasing our students' art in gym halls amidst training equipment, we'll have a common art gallery in a living, open public space. Everyone benefits in this atmosphere.

Athletics, both outdoors and indoors, will be transformed at our new campus. The efficiencies of a central location will be enormous for students, staff and parents.

STEM class

We'll have far less need for rental practice or game fields, busing to off-campus training facilities, or hauling and delivering equipment lacking a permanent home. Instead, we will have a stadium that seats 1,500, a football / soccer field, a baseball field, track and field facilities, plus basic amenities that pertain to fitness and all sports.

Indoor athletics will benefit by three gyms, a dance studio, and a multipurpose room for wrestling and other activities. A consolidated operation means more time for focusing on the main activity—building strong individuals, teams, and character.

EXPECTATION for High Community Impact Beyond Our Doors

In addition to being the world's largest independent school for intelligent students with learning differences, Shelton's three other enterprises provide solid professional resources for countless others.

- Evaluation Center Clients receive advanced diagnostic techniques that assess those with suspected learning disabilities and related disorders. They next receive a roadmap of helpful strategies for intervention and remediation.
- Speech / Language Therapy Program Clients receive individual and group therapy year-round on campus. In addition, Shelton's speech and screening services are in demand at 14 other Metroplex schools.
- Outreach / Training Multiple training programs (Montessori, numerous academic reading programs, and testing and referral courses) are offered yearround to the professionals who touch the lives of countless students. They educate and support those who work with the learning-different student population. National studies continue to cite the need for early identification and intervention, long Shelton's platform and practice.

We have exciting designs for three entrances at our new campus: 1) our main entrance, 2) our Fine Arts Center entrance, and 3) our stadium entrance. We have great expectations for those who enter and go forth from Shelton's doors. Thank you for your support as together we step forward with energy, enthusiasm, and expectation to serve more students, their families, and the professionals who serve them. We are making steady progress and anticipate a new year filled with the promise of more good things to come.

OUTREACH OFFERINGS

Christine Bedenbaugh, MAE, LDT, CALT, QI, Director Shelton Outreach/Training



This past year has been an exciting one for me personally and for the Outreach Department. I transitioned to the role of Director of Outreach/Training in June 2018. This is my 31st year as an educator and my 14th at Shelton. At Shelton I have taught in the middle school, acted as coordinator of the Alphabetic Phonics reading program used in grades two through eight, and directed Shelton's Academic Language Approach (SALA).

SALA is accredited by the International Multisensory Structured Language Education Council (IMSLEC). The SALA teacher training program is one of three IMSLECaccredited courses offered at Shelton. Sequential English Education (SEE), directed by Dr. Joyce Pickering, and Shelton Academic Reading Approach (SARA), directed by Nancy Coffman, are two additional courses offered which train teachers to become dyslexia specialists at both the Associate/Teaching and Therapy Levels. Graduates qualify to sit for the Alliance National Exam and, upon passing, can become certified at the Associate and Therapy Levels. Certified Academic Language Therapists (CALT) holding

> master's degrees may become Licensed Dyslexia Therapists in the state of Texas. We are proud to announce the number of teachers trained this year.

We are also pleased that teachers who attend our courses through the Therapy Level can earn all but six credit

hours toward a 30-credit hour Master of Arts degree in Multisensory Education through Dallas Baptist University, with whom we have had a long collaboration.

As the Director of SALA, I continue to train teachers in Keller ISD. Teaching Level training was also delivered on-site to five teachers from Irving ISD, as well as to teachers from Midlothian, Tyler, Dallas and Plano.

Nancy Coffman, formerly Shelton's Director of Outreach/Training, moved to North Carolina and now works remotely as Director of SARA. She has trained teachers in Alabama, Arkansas, Tennessee and Texas and presented reading workshops in Alabama, Arkansas, Connecticut, Louisiana, Minnesota, Tennessee and Texas. Nancy completed her term on the International Dyslexia's Executive Board this fall. Outreach is proud of her long service in the field of dyslexia.

G-g Shryer continued as the instructor for the summer Teaching Level course. A Teaching Level course and one course for CALTs, entitled Utilizing the Take Flight Curriculum. were conducted by G-q and Nancy during the summer. Nancy and I shared an additional Teaching and Therapy Level course during the school year.

Dr. Laure Ames, Director of Shelton's Evaluation Center, taught Diagnosing Learning Different Children: Referral and Testing, a required fiveday course for SEE, SARA, and SALA Therapy Level trainees. Dr. Ames also offered the one-day workshop, Screening for Dyslexia.



Parent Support Presentations

Outreach offers six workshops annually to new Shelton parents. They are also open to the public free of charge. Teachers may also attend and earn Continuing Education Units. Topics include:

- Overview of Learning Differences
- Simulations of Learning Differences*
- Social Skills/Organization and Study Skills
- Oral and Written Language: Decoding, Spelling, Comprehension and Composition
- Freedom from Chemical Dependency
- Math, Science and Social Studies
- *The Simulations of Learning Differences continues to be a popular and emotionally moving experience for attendees. This year a record number of over 400 people from throughout the Metroplex participated.

Saturday Seminars

Outreach staff offered 10 eight-hour Saturday seminars which are required for Therapy Level teacher trainees and open to the public for a nominal fee. Topics included:

- Organization and Study Skills
- Neurological Aspects of LD/Current Research
- The Shelton Model for Teaching Social Skills
- Discipline/Classroom Management
- Structural Math
- History of Language
- Phonological Awareness: Assessment, Analysis & Practical Application
- Oral Language Development
- Fluency and Comprehension
- Dyslexia Law/Composition
- MACAR/Child Development

Services from the office of the Executive Director Emerita include the work of **Dr. Joyce Pickering**, who directs both Multisensory Structured Language Education (MSLE) in Sequential English Education (SEE) and Montessori training at the Early Childhood, Elementary I and II levels.

Supervisory staff from this office are **Gulzar Babool** and **John Hodges**. **Pam Brockway** and **Claudia Hays** manage scheduling, travel and record-keeping of presentations and training done by this staff. John Hodges coordinates the *Shelton Scholars Program*, is co-coordinator with Dr. Pickering of the SEE training program, and presents the *Overview of Learning Differences* to many Metroplex

schools and districts. John has also made presentations in Slovenia and Plano this year. He is also supervising the creation of a Saturday program at Wesley-Rankin Community Center in West Dallas. Amy Kelton, head of Shelton's Upper Elementary division, and Joyce Pickering provide training and presentations in the U.S. and internationally.

Montessori Training

Gulzar Babool co-directs the Shelton Montessori Training Courses (SMT) with Dr. Pickering. She has an extensive background in Montessori education and administration. The two have visited all Montessori public schools in which Shelton provides staff training, including Dealey, MATA, Harry Stone in Dallas ISD, and Luna and Herfurth

in Garland ISD. Recently they have begun to train teachers from Fort Worth ISD. Gulzar also visits and regularly observes the trainees in the Elementary program, and **Cathy Luby** is the Field Supervisor for the Early Childhood (EC) trainees in both public and private schools. There are 117 trainees presently doing course and/or practicum work (36 in the EC course, 62 in the Elementary I course, and 19 in Elementary II).

MACAR

Montessori for Children at Risk for Learning Differences (MACAR) training has been presented to 83 students this year in Dallas and Shanghai, China. Shorter versions of MACAR have been given at White Rock Montessori in Dallas, Memphis, TN, and Midland, TX.

Another training for teachers in China is scheduled for June 2019. Two new courses will be added to SMT—Administration and Montessori Inclusion.

Short-Term Workshops

One- and two-day workshops have been given at Fairleigh Dickinson University in New Jersey, in Charlotte, NC for the Charlotte Montessori School, and at invited public and charter schools in Baton Rouge, LA for the Louisiana Montessori Association. Amy Kelton presented in Vancouver, Canada, New York City, NY, and Waukesha, WS.



In late October, Shelton hosted The Institute of Montessori Education's *Texas Montessori Back to School Conference* for 170 attendees. The event was one of two offered in the state of Texas.

MSLE-SEE Training

In June 2018, SEE Teaching Level and Therapy Level Training was offered on Shelton's campus. Thirty-three individuals attended, including students from Bridgemark Center in Tyler, TX, Brighton School in Baton Rouge, LA, Shelton and 13 individuals from other locations. SEE Therapy Level training included five participants from Bridgemark, Shelton, and one from outside our school contracts.

Literacy Instruction for Texas (LIFT) and **Wilkinson Centers** for adult literacy are also using the new adult literacy version of the SEE MSL program.

Next year the SEE training will continue at Brighton Academy, which will become a satellite training site. Presentations will be made at the American Montessori Society conference in Washington, D.C. in March 2019.

Shelton Outreach continues to serve students and teachers in the Dallas area, host events for the public, and to respond to national and international requests for information and training in the unique *Shelton Way*.



SPEECH, LANGUAGE, HEARING THERAPY PROGRAM

What Do We Do

The purpose of the Shelton Speech Language Therapy Program is to perform comprehensive evaluations and therapy for a variety of communication difficulties and disorders.

Therapists provide treatment to remediate challenges with:

- Articulation
- · Receptive/Expressive language
- Auditory processing
- Voice
- Fluency
- Social language
- Written language

Our therapists typically devote two full work days to serving students in other schools, often returning to the Shelton campus to provide after-school therapy.

- Serving approximately 160 clients city-wide
- Providing over 600 therapy sessions every week
- Performing screenings for 1,275 students every year

- Five full-time speech-language pathologists
- · Two part-time speech-language pathologists
- Seven "as needed" speech-language pathologists, six of whom are former Shelton therapists
- One administrative assistant

Speech Clinic therapists are always on the go! While the Speech Clinic provides private therapy for many Shelton students, one of the most vital operations of the Clinic takes place away from our campus—our comprehensive screening program. A screening is a brief assessment tool designed to identify potential problems. The Clinic provides full-service packages that include assessment for hearing, vision, speech, language, pre-literacy and reading. In addition to screening, Shelton Speech Clinic also provides speech-language therapy services in many schools in the Dallas Metroplex and prides itself on becoming a collaborative partner to other learning specialists, teachers and parents.

In addition to all the therapy and screenings done during the school year, Shelton's program also offers Language Adventures during the summer. The seven-week intensive therapy program is for children ages 3 - 5 who have receptive and expressive language delays. Each week themed activities are offered as part of language enrichment. Popular themes include sports, the circus, farms, and camping. Speech therapy interns from local colleges also have supervised hands-on experiences with Shelton's professional staff.

Retaining Core Services and Expanding Through the Assessment of Autism Spectrum Disorder

At the Shelton Evaluation Center, (SEC), our primary services for over 40 years have included:

- Psychoeducational evaluations that assess problems with learning
- Evaluations specific to the diagnosis of Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- · Psychological evaluations

Today we are also able to assist many of our clients with the assessment for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

ASD is not a learning disorder. It is a broad developmental disorder that is neurological in nature. About one in 59 children is diagnosed with ASD, a rate that has increased by 15 percent in the last two years. People on the autism spectrum are in every classroom and every workplace. Some are diagnosed, and some are not. Higher functioning people may not fully manifest symptoms until adolescence or beyond when social demands exceed their more limited capacities. People diagnosed with ASD range from brilliant engineers, computer programmers, and physicians to individuals who may have to live in an assisted living situation. ASD affects four areas of functioning:

- 1) language / communication
- 2) social skills
- 3) sensory systems
- 4) behavior

According to the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual-Fifth Edition, (DSM-5), the diagnostic criteria for diagnosing ASD (currently, or by history) includes: deficits in social-emotional reciprocity, deficits in nonverbal communication, deficits in developing and keeping and understanding relationships, stereotyped or repetitive movements or speech, inflexibility and insistence on

sameness, restricted and fixated interests, and hyper- or hypo-reactivity to sensory input. To make a diagnosis, symptoms must cause clinically significant impairment in social, occupational, or other areas of current functioning.

A comprehensive

evaluation is done at the SEC to diagnose ASD and is usually done in conjunction with a psychoeducational evaluation that assesses cognitive ability, attention, and academics. Measures would include a combination of: Clinical Interview, Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule-Second Edition (ADOS-2), Autism Spectrum Rating Scales (ASRS), Childhood Autism Rating Scale-Second Edition (CARS-2), Social Responsiveness Scale-Second Edition (SRS-2), Autism Diagnostic Interview, Revised (ADI-R), and the Social Language Development Test. Measures of anxiety and depression may also be included.

Early recognition and diagnosis of children with ASD is essential because behavioral and educational interventions can improve the prognosis, especially for peer interactions and the development of language. Identifying the disorder and engaging in appropriate interventions can help a family to cope better; not knowing the child's diagnosis increases parental anxiety and delays interventions that can reduce behavioral, emotional, and social problems.

The SEC has had another busy year working with clients from Switzerland, New York, Vermont, Kansas, Louisiana, Arizona, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Washington,

Tennessee, and Texas. Best of all, it is a strategy that can be practiced anywhere during the stressful moments in life, whether before a test or an activity that is new that brings feelings of uncertainty.

Kindness Reigns and Rocks

activities. Using their creativity and problem-solving skills, they create a propeller car using popsicle sticks, blocks, wheels, and a propeller. Students also use TinkerCad software to create a 3D printed phone stand and a 3D car chassis to be raced for both speed and distance.

As part of our school-wide partnership with Tech EdVentures, seventh-grade students are learning to code using the Python language and a unique pocket-sized computer called Micro:Bit. Through this curriculum, students learn the fundamentals of using a written programming language, including planning a program, conditional statements, data storage, loops, random numbers and choices, and debugging. Projects include creation of custom images and animations, sequencing images and text to tell an interactive story, using buttons to advance through a program, and a "reaction" game that tallies points when a user pressed the right button. Students also gain public speaking experience by presenting their finished products to the class.



Shelton Libraries are Unlike Any Others

Libraries and media centers are mainstays of the educational process at Shelton. A few stats help tell the story of the integral emphasis we place on them:

Circulation Inventory

(56,968 total number of books and catalogued items) Secondary 27,595 books and catalogued items Elementary 29,373 books and catalogued items

Shelton clearly exceeds the American Association of School Libraries (AASL) average recommendation of 12,673.

Shelton libraries provide 62 books per student. The American Library Association recommends 18. Texas state standards recommend 8 books.

Shelton's FYE overall library expenditure is \$54 per student. AASL reports Texas average expenditure per student is \$19.93.

Shelton libraries FYE spends \$18,682 on subscription databases. AASL 2012 national average was \$13,525.

Author Inspired Audiences

Austin author Chris Barton (Shark vs. Train, The Day-Glo Brothers, What Do You Do with a Voice Like That?) gave four popular presentations to Shelton students in September and participated in a book-signing. Barton is also the co-founder of Modern First Library.



Book Fair

The annual book fair was a smashing success. Faculty and staff shopped for books while enjoying coffee and sweet breads. Parents enjoyed browsing and buying from Oct. 19 - 26,

including parent conference days. Many fathers visited campus for Books and Bagels or Lunch with Dads, and a few were a soft touch for book purchases while they were here. Historical fiction author Jennifer Nielsen (Resistance, The Runaway King) added to the book fair activities with a presentation to middle and high school students, including an autograph-signing.

Shelton Celebrates Academic Success of Two Seniors


Two seniors have made news with the National Merit Scholarship (NMS) ranks.

Etan Cohn has been named as Shelton's first-ever semifinalist in the 2019 National Merit Scholarship Program. He is one of 16,000 semifinalists announced September 12th by officials of the NMS Corporation.

Over 1.6 million juniors in some 22,000 high schools across the nation entered the program by taking the 2017 Preliminary SAT/NMS Qualifying Test (PSAT / NMSQT®). Etan and other semifinalists represent less than one percent of each state's high school seniors. Semifinalists may continue in the NMSC competition for 7,500 NM Scholarships totaling more than \$31 million to be awarded in spring 2019. Typically, some 15,000 semifinalists will advance as finalists. From these, Merit Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of these students' accomplishments and abilities. Etan has been at Shelton since 2006. A versatile student, he has been actively involved in band, drumline and soccer.






