It's been another exciting and eventful year at Shelton. The semester began with welcoming more than 900 students. From the moment they walked onto campus, these incredible young people have set themselves apart in the classroom and in the community.

Already this fall, a Shelton senior was recognized as a Commended

Student in the 2018 National Merit Scholarship Program, while two Middle School students spent Labor Day helping Hurricane Harvey victims. Shelton's Theatre Arts department performed Shakespeare's *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, and all of the school celebrated United Nation's International Day of Peace led by our Early Childhood (EC) – 2nd grade students who sang *Light a Candle for Peace*.

Shelton has, for more than 40 years, fulfilled the vision, philosophy and commitment to excellence put into practice by Dr. June Shelton. Our 2016-2017 academic year concluded with the graduation of 67 students who were accepted into 103 college and universities and

offered \$4,534,077 in merit scholarships. Fifteen of our 6th-graders qualified for the Duke University Talent Identification Program and the Upper School hosted the 17th Annual Ethics Symposium and the Leaders for Life program. Shelton students are truly incredible, due in large part because of the generosity of our donors who appreciate the School as a gift to the community and to our students.

Shelton Responds to Legislation with Seminars

The Texas legislature recently passed House Bill 1886. This bill requires that all students in kindergarten and first grade be screened for dyslexia. The bill also requires continuing education for educators who teach students with dyslexia, including training regarding new research and practices in educating students with dyslexia. In response to this legislation, Shelton has developed multiple seminars.

Dr. Laure Ames, Director of Shelton Evaluation Center, designed a one-day workshop, *Screening for Dyslexia*. This seminar is appropriate for any professional working to identify dyslexia. This includes principals, SPED Directors, 504 Coordinators, curriculum and instruction coordinators, literacy directors, and Dyslexia Therapists. The seminar covers the unique markers of dyslexia as it applies to identification, the biological basis of dyslexia, and early warning signs of dyslexia. Dr. Ames is uniquely qualified to share her knowledge allowing those who give screenings to be able to “go beyond the scores” when identifying students with dyslexia and related disorders. This seminar was offered in November and will be offered again in February (see *Evaluation Center*, pg. 8).

In addition to the screening seminar, Nancy Coffman, Director of Outreach/Training, developed a series of four seminars designed to raise the knowledge base for general education teachers in the areas of multisensory instruction, reading, and spelling. The goal is to better serve all students, including those students with dyslexia and related disorders. These seminars can be taken in series or as individual seminars. The four seminars include *Multisensory Instruction Across the Curriculum*; *Reading Development and Phonemic Awareness*; *Reading Mechanics: Sight Words, Learned Words, and Decodable Words*; and *Spelling: Who Knew There Were Rules?* These seminars will be offered in late January, early February and again in August.

Shelton Outreach/Training continues to explore ways to share the strong knowledge base of the Shelton staff. These seminars are designed to add to the knowledge base of general education professionals in order to better serve students with dyslexia and related disorders in public school settings. These seminars are a complement to the more extensive training offered to educators who specialize in serving these students, whether in public or in private settings. All training opportunities can be found on the Shelton website.

Joyce S. Pickering, Hum.D., Shelton Executive Director Emerita

This past year has been a busy and exciting year for Outreach from the Executive Director Emerita's office. Services from this office include the work of **Pam Brockway** and **Claudia Hays**, who coordinate the appointments, travel and record-keeping of all presentations and training done by this staff. **John Hodges** coordinates the *Shelton Scholars* tutoring program and presents the *Overview of Learning Differences* to many metroplex schools and districts. **Amy Kelton** and I supervise the Sequential English Education (SEE) multisensory structured language training and make presentations throughout the U.S. and abroad.



Gulzar Babool

Gulzar Babool is the new co-director, alongside me, of the Shelton Montessori Training Courses. She has an extensive background in Montessori education and administration. Gulzar and I have visited all the Montessori public schools in which Shelton is providing staff training, including Dealey Montessori, Eduardo Mata Elementary, Harry Stone (each Dallas ISD) and Luna and Hereford in Garland ISD.

Gulzar also visits and observes trainees in these schools and numerous private schools on a regular schedule. There are 80 trainees presently doing coursework and/or a practicum.

We have made presentations on Montessori for Children at Risk for Learning Differences (MACAR) in Dallas, TX (Whiterock Montessori), Edinburg, TX, and in Denver, CO, LaPort, IN, and Shanghai, China. One hundred and sixty-eight students have received the training.

We also delivered presentations on *Montessori and Learning Differences* to Xavier University in Cincinnati, OH, Castle Montessori in Frisco, TX, and the International Montessori Congress in Prague. **Amy Kelton** presented in Canada twice this year.

For the past three years, I have worked with **Karen Guida** at Literacy Instruction for Texas (**LIFT**), providing training in the SEE method. This year Karen and I created a new version of SEE specifically for adult literacy, and this material is available, with training, to other adult literacy programs. **Wilkinson Centers** for adult literacy have also begun using the program.

In 2018, the SEE training will continue at **Brighton Academy** in Baton Rouge, LA, and presentations will be made at the **American Montessori Society** (AMS) conference in Denver, CO and at the **Academic Language Therapy Association** (ALTA) conference in Dallas.



Additional training for Montessori teachers in China is scheduled for June 2018. Some of them will visit Shelton in March to experience the Shelton program before taking the MACAR training. We have received a request for training in New Zealand, and plans for 2018 are being finalized.

It is our privilege to serve students and professionals locally, statewide, nationally and internationally in the unique *Shelton Way*.

SPEECH, LANGUAGE, HEARING THERAPY PROGRAM

The mission of the Speech, Language, Hearing Therapy Program remains to serve students and families, at Shelton and in the community alike, by providing thorough and informative screens, comprehensive speech and language evaluations, and, of course, speech therapy services of the highest quality. We could never begin to fulfill this mission without our team of experienced and caring

clinicians. Our therapists have a combined total of 137 years of experience! We are thankful for the opportunity to provide support to each student with unique learning needs. Our greatest goal is to help our clients realize success by giving them the tools to better communication.

Screening Program

Our Speech, Language, Reading, Hearing and Vision screening program is one component that is vital to fulfilling our mission. Early intervention is critical not only for closing language learning gaps and providing a stable foundation upon which to build future language, but also for avoiding frustration and allowing a child to maintain self-esteem and confidence in his or her ability to communicate. Through the screening process, the Shelton Speech Therapy Program provides invaluable assistance to parents and educators by identifying young children with speech, language and reading delays. From individual conferences and professionally written results to recommendations for intervention, our therapists work alongside parents and teachers to

support their children in a way that is unique to Shelton. For these reasons, we believe Shelton's Speech Therapy Program is providing the gold standard in the Dallas area for speech, language, and reading screenings.

Therapy Services

Shelton therapists complete approximately 150 therapy sessions each and every week. We provide private speech, language, reading and social communication therapy not only to Shelton students, EC to high school, but to students in private schools across the Metroplex including Hockaday, Greenhill, Parish Episcopal, ESD, Spring Creek Daycare, St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic, Lamplighter and Westwood Montessori. In addition, many community clients are seen by us on Shelton's campus. Therapy is provided for receptive and expressive language, articulation, language and auditory processing, phonological awareness and reading difficulties, reading comprehension, and social language. In addition, several of our therapists are trained in the multisensory reading methods that are used so successfully by Shelton School. Therapy is available year round, Monday through Thursday, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Another important part of our work with students is our Social Communication program for those students with social cognition challenges. Using a Social Thinking (Winner, 2000) model of therapy, groups and individuals are not simply taught to memorize social routines, but explicitly taught the thought process behind social interaction. Students practice using one's language skills to seek information; listening that involves not simply taking in auditory information, but integrating information for a deeper concept, when all messages cannot be taken literally; gaining skills for abstract

and inferential language; and interpreting others perspectives, thoughts and feelings across contexts.

Summer Offerings

Therapy doesn't stop in the summer. Shelton's Speech Therapy Program continues to offer speech and language camps, as well as private therapy. Our therapists, along with speech therapy graduate student interns from The University of Texas at Dallas and Texas Women's University, host students of all ages in therapeutic camps that are both impactful and fun.

iSocialize

This group therapy targets Social Thinking and related social skills for elementary age children. This therapeutic group teaches the "why" behind social interaction including perspective taking, thinking about others, expected vs. unexpected behaviors, active listening, and language for conversation.

Shelton therapists were on the move again this past summer as we partnered with *Summer on the Hill* at The Greenhill School to provide a week-long Social Language Summer Camp for 23 elementary age campers. We plan to partner again with other schools for summer programs.

Screenings begin in August and usually conclude in January. Each year Shelton Speech screens approximately 1,200 children.



Language Adventures

Our five-week intensive therapy program for children ages 3-5 with receptive and expressive language delays is expanding to seven weeks this summer. Each week language enriching activities are planned within a thematic framework, such as camping, sports, circus and farm.

SHELTON EVALUATION CENTER

Laure Ames, Ph.D., Director

The Shelton Evaluation Center has had a full year as staff worked with clients from Louisiana, Arkansas, Washington, California, Kansas, New Mexico and all over Texas. Our goal when conducting a psychoeducational evaluation or an evaluation for Autism Spectrum Disorder is to obtain a comprehensive picture of the client's functioning so that we can make appropriate recommendations for intervention. Our Evaluation Center is unique in the Dallas area because our staff is experienced in offering multiple kinds of evaluations and integrating information from them to make targeted recommendations and referrals. Our staff members are committed to remaining informed through ongoing professional development in order to do this.

Stephanie McCain, LPA, LSSP attended Texas Woman University's School Neuropsychology Summer Institute in July. She was introduced to the second edition of the Test of Everyday Attention in Children (TEA-Ch2), a measure used to examine executive functioning in children. Deficits in executive functioning are often tied to AD/HD, anxiety, and/or Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). She also attended a session focusing on the neuropsychological symptoms of ASD and how to devise the best testing battery to assess for these characteristics in making an ASD diagnosis.

Catherine Harris, LSSP attended the Texas Association of School Psychologists (TASP) Annual Convention in November. She learned about Restorative Justice, which prioritizes social-emotional development and relationship repair rather than the traditional punitive measures typically used in schools. Sessions also

covered the concept of educational need for students identified with Autism, with an emphasis on the school's responsibility to develop social and communication skills even when academic performance is strong.

Jacqueline Pack, LP, LSSP attended a Legal Digest Workshop in October. She learned about updates to laws that impact education. Some of the updated laws pertain to bullying and dyslexia services.

With regard to these new laws, the Texas legislature recently passed House Bill 1886. This bill requires that all students in public school be screened for dyslexia at the end of kindergarten and first grade. In response to this new law, I designed a one-day workshop called **Dyslexia Screening: a Shelton Workshop** for professionals working in the public schools. The workshop covers the characteristics of dyslexia, the biological basis of dyslexia, what must be assessed to identify dyslexia in a young student, and how the universal screening measures work. The workshop was offered in November and will be offered again in February. I also teach a more in-depth course in February and June entitled **Diagnosing the Learning Different Child**. This course provides an overview of the diagnostic criteria for a Language Disorder, a Specific Learning Disorder with impairment in reading (dyslexia), and dysgraphia, the most common learning disabilities. ADHD, one of the most common behavioral difficulties, and Autism Spectrum Disorder, one of the most common developmental disorders, are also reviewed. A typical battery of tests used to evaluate these difficulties is taught and case studies are presented.

Fifth-Graders Visit Bureau of Printing and Engraving

Students learned to check their bills for a small fw for Fort Worth denoting currency. 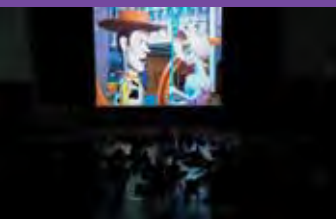
Next on stage is another classic, Meredith Wilson's *The Music Man*. The musical takes place in February 2018.

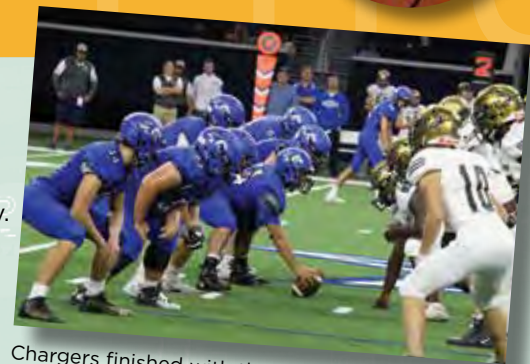

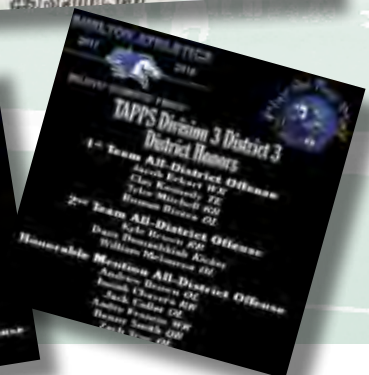
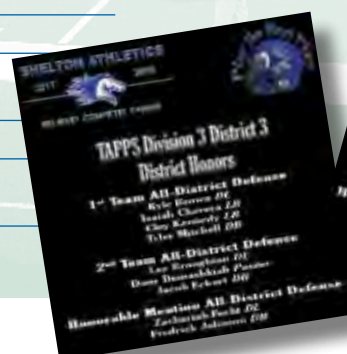

Shelton and Tech EdVentures Partner for Coding Curriculum

Coding, robotics, drones, and fun! Shelton School and Tech EdVentures, a Dallas-based company founded by **Allen Selis, Ph.D.**, have partnered to create a coding curriculum specifically designed for children who learn differently. Over the next three years, coding curriculum will be developed for grades PP-12. Many of our students will grow up to work in cutting-edge fields that did not exist in the past using technologies that might not be invented until years from now. Both parties recognize that engineering, coding, problem-solving, and collaboration need to be accessible for all students to prepare them for a lifetime of success.

This fall, Shelton began this significant partnership with Tech EdVentures to develop and implement the coding curriculum for grades PP-5. This curriculum builds upon Montessori practices while orienting itself to the needs of Shelton students. The result so far has been an explosion of interest in coding among young learners and a feeling of excitement within the school community. The development of this curriculum for Middle School will begin next year and the Upper School curriculum development will begin in 2019.

"Prowess in STEM education opens doors to great colleges and great jobs, and research shows that the earlier students start, the more likely they are to develop a deep confidence in their own abilities with math, science and computer programming," says Shelton board member and former Texas Instruments executive **Terri West**, who connected Shelton and Tech EdVentures. "Tech EdVentures makes STEM fun, and that's a crucial step toward making students successful." The three-year project is made possible by Alliance Data.

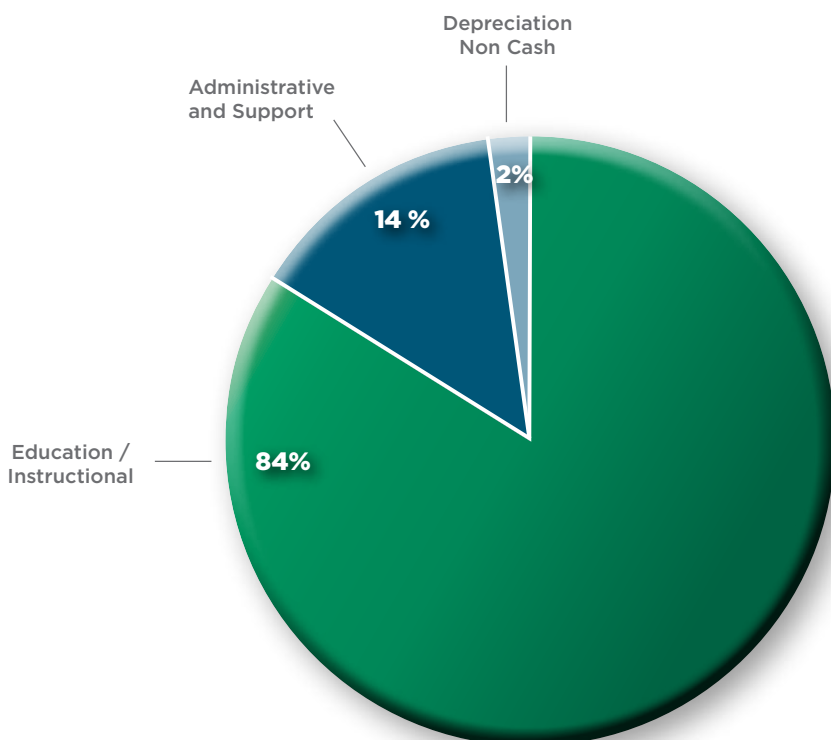
