FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Shelton Launches Leaders for Life

I am excited to announce that we have launched a formal leadership training program for our high school students. We've always mentored leaders at Shelton - each and every day - but we've never formalized our training in such a manner.

Our new program is called *Leaders for Life*, and it is designed to equip and empower our students with lifelong leadership skills. It complements our social skills program, our high school ethics curriculum, and our annual ethics symposium.

We are honored that Alliance Data is the corporate sponsor for our program. "Education is the backbone of a vibrant economy. Schools like Shelton and programs like Leaders for Life give all students a chance to not only learn valuable leadership skills, but give them the foundation to become successful contributing members of their communities," says our friend Ed Heffernan, President and Chief Executive Officer of Alliance Data.

David Ash was featured speaker at our inaugural program in September. Ash, who graduated from The University of Texas at Austin with a Master's of Science in Finance, played quarterback

for the Longhorns during his undergraduate years and was a two-time member of the Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll. He talked with students about leading from the heart. He recounted how, when he no longer played quarterback, he saw his football jersey for sale in the student coop for 50 percent off. "Whether or not they were selling my jersey at a discount, I was still 100 percent a leader, and I never changed the way I felt about that though my football status had changed."

Second in our lineup for Leaders for Life was an October presentation by Mary C. Kelly, PhD, CSP, Commander, US Navy (ret). Her topic, Students Building Bridges, was based on her best-selling book, Master Your World: 10 Dog-Inspired Leadership Lessons. Kelly's points included:

- Build bridges, not fences (help others)
- Reward positive behavior
- Don't reward poor behavior
- Help others succeed (share tools, resources)
- Take the appropriate action at the appropriate time

Dr. Kelly returned in November, when her topic was Leading with Gratitude: How to Appreciate, Cooperate and Graduate. Using a Thanksgiving theme, key points included:

- Keep a positive attitude when events don't go well
- Be appreciative of both big and little gifts
- Create a positive vision
- · Maintain an overall perspective and don't succumb to negativity

Dr. Kelly returns to Shelton this spring with her program, *Money Smart:* Dr. Mary Kelly engages students How Not to Buy Cat Food When You Don't Have a Cat.

I'm particularly pleased with this new program. Many times schools implement a leadership program that primarily benefits the already known school student leaders, e.g. student council officers or class presidents. Leaders for Life will be an ongoing long term offering for all of our high school students. Everyone carries leadership potential, and it's our goal to teach and hone these skills at Shelton.

Multisensory Structured Language Education (MSLE). I have repeatedly seen growth in teacher knowledge scores after the International Dyslexia Association (IDA) and International MSLE Council (IMSLEC) accredited training that we provide. Students, identified as having reading disabilities, show great growth in oral reading fluency after receiving instruction from those teachers. Thus, I have written articles showing that *some things that count, can be counted!*

Here I want to share the non-quantifiable aspects of the improvement that I witness—the things *that count, but cannot be counted*. I am blessed to hear from public school teachers in our training program on a regular basis. These teachers, from all across the socio-economic spectrum, share stories that humble and inspire me. Here are but a few:

I have worked with this 4th grade student since the first grade using various interventions. Now in his second year of Take Flight, he reads and works with a confidence that I have never seen before! His DIBELS scores are climbing, and his teachers are commenting on how well he is doing in the classroom!

The Matthew Effect

Keith Stanovich^{*} gave us the term "The Matthew Effect," describing the negative impact of reading difficulties in students. To paraphrase, "In reading, the rich get richer and the poor get poorer." When we give students the tools needed for reading with an intensity and duration that is appropriate for their skill profile, we change lives. These are results that matter but cannot be measured. We change poor readers to rich readers!

Shelton serves some 900 students per year on our campus. We change lives every day. Through the training that is offered through our Outreach / Training division, we estimate that we serve over 14,000 students across the country in both public and private schools. As one of our tagline says, Shelton is truly *more than a school!*

SHELTON OUTREACH IS EVERYWHERE

It is amazing to see the teachers who come to our Multisensory Structured Language Education (MSLE) training courses. Some have master's degrees in education, some are reading specialists and yet, two days into our courses they are saying, "Why did no one teach me these skills before?" Many are angry that they have spent time and money in college and university courses and have not actually been taught to teach reading. Few have even heard of reading disorders or how to address the needs of students with Dyslexia and Related Disorders. Having worked in the field of language and learning disorders for 55 years, I have seen some improvement in the recognition of these learning differences. However, colleges and university reading courses in most places still include little on how to help the 15-20% of the population who process written language inaccurately and more slowly. Our Montessori Applied to Children at Risk (MACAR) program helps teachers and schools learn how to provide early intervention, so that students do not experience early confusion and frustration.

These students are intelligent and have the ability to contribute much to society. They work hard to achieve in school despite their struggling with processing words as they read, or with spelling and writing their thoughts in written expression assignments. They have strengths in math, processing in three-dimensional space, computer science, and business. Many become architects, contractors, computer scientists, sculptors, artists, and company CEO's based on their talents and intelligence. Yet they struggle in school with a very specific challenge, processing words, allowing them to read, spell and write at the level of their intellect. There is no group of students with learning challenges that can be so thoroughly remediated and become as highly productive. Sadly, in most private and public schools many of these students are not recognized or instructed appropriately. Why? Because teachers are uninformed, and many of the students have found ways to compensate as best they can in school, frequently not gualifying for educational



intervention services. This is a huge loss to society. Some achieve in spite of their differences. Others become anxious and depressed. Many cannot achieve their potential, because they don't get the help they need. This lack of service, according to Reid Lyon, former director of the National Center for Health for Child Development, is educational malpractice.

For 41 years Shelton has provided learning different students the help that offers life-changing opportunity, enabling them to achieve and contribute in many fields.

Through Shelton's Outreach Program, teachers in the U.S. and around the world have been trained to teach those with Learning Differences. Students attending the Shelton Scholars program here on campus have been helped in the skills they need to achieve.

Shelton School, Outreach / Training Program, Evaluation Center and Speech Language Therapy Program have helped thousands of teachers and students since 1976. Shelton is a demonstration center for those who wish to emulate our unique Shelton program. People from all over the U.S., Europe, Asia, and South America have visited to learn how they can empower more students for success.

The mission of the Speech, Language, Hearing Therapy Program has long been to serve students and families, at Shelton and in the community alike, by providing thorough and informative screenings, comprehensive speech and language evaluations, and, of course, speech therapy services of the highest quality. We could never begin to fulfill this mission without our team of experienced and

caring clinicians. We have a combined total of 130 years of experience. Our greatest goal is to help our clients realize success by giving them the tools for better communication.

Screening Program

Our Speech, Language, Reading, Hearing and Vision screening program is vital to fulfilling our mission. Early intervention is critical not only for closing language learning gaps and providing a stable foundation upon which to build future language, but also for avoiding frustration and allowing a child to maintain self-esteem and confidence in his ability to communicate. Through the screening process, we provide invaluable assistance to parents and educators by identifying young children with speech, language and reading delays. From individual conferences and professionally written results to recommendations for intervention, therapists in our clinic come alongside parents and teachers to support their children in a way that is unique to Shelton. For these reasons, the Shelton Speech Therapy Program is becoming the gold standard in the Dallas area for speech, language, and reading screenings.

Screenings begin in August and usually conclude in January. We usually screen approximately 1,200 children annually.

Therapy Services

The Speech Therapy Program therapists complete approximately 150 therapy sessions each week. We provide private speech, language, reading and social communication therapy not only to Shelton students, EC to high school, but to students in private schools across the metroplex including Hockaday, Greenhill, Parish Episcopal, ESD, Spring Creek Daycare, St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic, Lamplighter and Westwood Montessori. In addition, many community clients are seen in the Speech Clinic on Shelton's campus. Therapy is provided for receptive and expressive language, articulation, language and auditory processing, phonological awareness and reading difficulties, reading comprehension, and social language. In addition, several of our therapists are trained in the multisensory reading methods that are used so successfully by Shelton School. Therapy is available year round, Monday through Thursday, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Another expanding therapy service is our Social Communication program for students with social cognition challenges. Using a Social Thinking (Winner, 2000) model of therapy, groups and individuals are not simply taught to memorize social routines, but explicitly taught the thought process behind social interaction.

SHELTON

Students practice using one's language skills to seek information; listening that involves not simply taking in auditory information, but integrating information for a deeper concept, when all messages cannot be taken literally; gaining skills for abstract and inferential language; and interpreting others perspectives, thoughts and feelings across contexts. Our fastest growing group of social clients is the College Prep high school students. We have several therapists with Social Thinking training who offer individual and group social cognition therapy to clients of all ages.

Summer Programs

We continue to offer speech and language camps and private therapy throughout the summer. Therapists and graduate student interns from UTD and TWU host children of all ages in therapeutic camps that are both impactful and fun. Summer offerings also include Language Adventures, Articulation Adventures and iSocialize. Check our website for details.

Professional Training

The Speech Clinic is a vital resource for teaching undergraduate and graduate students completing their degrees in speechlanguage pathology. We are a sought after off-site placement for interns each semester. We provide a variety of experiences to graduate students from assessment to therapy for all ages.

In 2013, the Speech Clinic was instrumental in the acceptance of Shelton School as an ASHA approved provider of continuing education for therapists not only at Shelton, but to professionals in surrounding communities and the country.

ASHA Approved CE Providers plan, conduct, evaluate, and continuously improve their continuing education (CE) courses using the standards and requirements established by the ASHA Continuing Education Board.

We are planning to host another professional training seminar for Texas therapists in 2017.

SHELTON EVALUATION CENTER

Laure Ames, Ph.D., Director



The Shelton Evaluation Center has had a busy year and our staff has worked with clients from Malaysia, Canada, Louisiana, Arkansas, and all over Texas. When we evaluate a client through either a psychoeducational, psychological, Autism Spectrum Disorder, and/ or ADHD evaluation, our goal is to obtain a comprehensive picture of the client's functioning so that we can make appropriate recommendations. If any student is struggling, we should want to know

why. Correct diagnoses help guide how to best help the student be as successful as possible. The remediation and/or accommodations that we recommend are tied to the diagnoses we make.

The most common diagnoses that we make here are Specific Learning Disorder with impairment in reading (Dyslexia), Language Disorder, Dysgraphia, Attention Deficit/ Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Dyslexia is a specific language-based learning disability that is neurological in origin. It is characterized by difficulties with accurate and/or fluent word recognition and by poor spelling and decoding abilities (IDA 2012). Once dyslexia is identified, we would recommend academic language therapy with a Certified Academic Language Therapist (CALT). The most intensive therapy would be through a special school like Shelton School. Examples of accommodations for dyslexia might include

- extend time for reading assignments
- use books on tape
- waive a foreign language requirement

A spoken language disorder, also known as an **oral language disorder**, represents a significant impairment in the acquisition and use of language across any of the five language domains (i.e., phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, pragmatics). Work with a speech-language pathologist would be the recommended remediation. Examples of accommodations might include

- give extra time to process and formulate answers
- encourage teachers to ensure understanding of the assignment
- rephrase the information using less complex language
- re-deliver instructions on a one-to-one basis

Dysgraphia can refer to extreme problems with handwriting, spelling, and written composition. It can also refer to handwriting difficulties only. Remediation would be through occupational therapy, and accommodations might include

- use a laptop or word processor during class lectures
- get copies of the instructor's lecture notes
- use a tape recorder during class lectures

ADHD is a persistent pattern of inattention and/or hyperactivity and impulsivity. Treatment is usually through consultation with a psychiatrist or neurologist for medication management. An organizational coach is often beneficial. Accommodations might include

- use preferential seating
- use separate room for tests
- have assistance keeping track of assignments and materials
- allow breaks during class and testing

Finally, **Autism Spectrum Disorder** is a developmental disorder characterized by persistent deficits in social communication and social interaction across multiple contexts and restricted, repetitive patterns of behavior, interests, or activities. Treatment may include

- Social Thinking curriculum
- speech-language therapy
- social skills training
- Applied Behavior Analysis

The Shelton Evaluation Center is unique in the Dallas area because our staff is experienced in offering multiple kinds of evaluations and integrating the information from these different evaluations in order to




These productions are a boon of portfolio opportunities for several filmmaking students.





Shelton Students Attend Hart Global Leaders Forum









