

## Cline Masterworks Presentation Guide Sheet

### ✍ Part 1

- Give students time to view art (approx. 5 minutes)
- Lead students in discussion about what they see in the art (colors/shapes/subject/light/etc.—approx.7-10 minutes)

### ✍ Part 2

- Provide overview of information about artist(s)/genre, including, but not necessarily limited to:
  - birth/death dates and locations
  - where art was made
  - distinct characteristics of the artist's/genre's style
- Approx. 5-7 minutes

### ✍ Part 3

- Art Activity (20-25 minutes)
  - Try to make the activity tie to the artist/genre and their characteristics

### General/Preparation:

- ✍ Use the Internet for background information about art and artists
- ✍ YouTube has many videos related to the art and artist we present and some of the shorter ones may be appropriate to incorporate into your presentation; however, always make sure you check with the teacher before your presentation to make sure it is all right for you to use their monitor/computer
