Open House

August 28, 4:00-6:00 p.m.

Please stop by the cafeteria to “check things out” before school begins. The cafeteria will have several information tables that you will not want to miss. You will have an opportunity to:

- Put money in your lunch account.
- Purchase student planners for grades 1-4 (\$5.00); Students in grades 5 and 6 will use school iPads in lieu of planners.
- Pick up your pre-ordered school supplies.
- Learn about the PTO.

After visiting the cafeteria, you can:

- Find your classroom (maps are available in the cafeteria, the OP office located on the top floor, or posted on the hall signboards).
- Put your school supplies in your classroom.

If you cannot attend the Open House, you may send money with your student on the first day of school to purchase lunch credits and planner (September 3).

SCHOOL LUNCH & BREAKFAST

All students will be assigned a Personal Identification Number (PIN). Checks should be made payable to EPFS (Eden Prairie Food Service) and placed in an envelope with student’s name on the front. Students not attending the Open House will receive their PIN numbers on the first day of school and they may purchase meal credits at that time or pay using the on-line VANCO system accessed through the parent portal.

EARLY DISMISSAL/LATE ARRIVAL

If you want to pick your child up before school dismisses, please send a note with your child stating the time and reason. All pick-ups will be at our main security entrance on the top floor during school hours.
