- scissors

- 1 pocket folder for homework
- box of 24 count Crayola crayons (Do not buy washable crayons)
- box of colored pencils (12-24)
- \$5 for supplies provided by the teacher in an envelope with your child's name (this will pay for student planner, journals, classroom folders)

The following items would also be helpful if you would like to donate some extra things to our classroom community:

- paper towels
- Kleenex
- Liquid hand soap
- baby wipes and disinfecting wipes
