R	Restate the prompt/question and turn the prompt/question into a sentence starter.
	Answer/Address ALL parts of the prompt. Together, the R and A will create a claim statement/topic sentence.
C	Cite multiple relevant pieces of evidence directly from the text to support your claim. Evidence looks like:  Relevant direct quotes, brief summaries, and paraphrases (author's words/ideas written in your own words.) Be sure that evidence is significant to the answer. 	Explain the evidence to demonstrate a deep understanding. It should effectively connect with your answer, which proves your point.  Remember: Your written response should include more written analysis than evidence to support your claim.  Summarize the purpose of the paragraph.
