### Superintendent's Recommendations for Approval

  - a. These books include novels and grammar textbooks for high school English classes and Speech and Language books.
3. [Approval of Appointment, District Summer Program Staff](#)
  - a. These are interventionists to provide math summer classes for students identified for the Stepping Up to Grade 8 math and Algebra I classes and funded by Title Grants.
4. [Approval of Additional Summer Curriculum Writers](#)
  - a. A few teachers have been identified to revise high school English and middle school music curricula.

  - a. Annually, we are required to approve the evaluation systems that are used for teachers and administrators. Our district uses the Marshall Evaluation System for Principals and the Danielson Framework for Faculty.

These are grants that we are awarded to primarily support students that are identified for special education, intervention, English Language Learning, and Gifted and Talented as well as professional development for teachers that work with these students. This funding allows us to provide programs for students to enhance their learning experiences.
8. [Approval of Memorandum of Understanding Between the Title III Consortium Fiscal Agent and Member Districts for Fiscal Year 2019-2020](#) for ELL management.
  - a. Our Title III allocation for next year is below the threshold required for managing it ourselves. Therefore, in order to use these funds, we need to maintain our participation in Eatontown's consortium.

  - a. We are very grateful to the Indian Hill Parent Liaison Group for 4 generous donations including:

- i. a monetary donation of \$9,849.95 for the iPads and supporting technology to be used in the Indian Hill School art and music programs.
- ii. a monetary donation of \$5,274.46 for the projectors and supporting technology for Indian Hill Classrooms.
- iii. a non-monetary donation valued at \$14,670.00 to upgrade the Indian Hill School Stage Audio System.
- iv. a non-monetary donation valued at \$3,500.00 for a 5-year contract agreement between the Indian Hill PLG with Stealth Productions for audio performance system management and operation for the fall and spring performances.
