

# Kindergarten Unit 1-Shapes and Counting

In this unit students will:

- Write and Count numbers 0-20.
- Count to tell numbers of objects
- Sort objects into categories
- Name shapes to describe objects
- Use terms such as *above*, *below*, *beside*, *in front of*, *behind*, and *next to* in order to describe relative positions of objects
- Create addition number stories up to 20.

Home Support:

- Practice counting sets of objects (such as shoes, stuffed animals, etc) and arranging them in different ways.
- Practice writing numbers up to 20 by: writing numbers in the air, using a pencil or crayon to write numbers on a paper, write numbers on a white board.
- Practice identifying shapes by showing your child shapes and having them name and sort them.
- Practice addition stories by using child's toys such as cars, stuffed animals etc. Example: 2 cars + 2 cars
