Kindergarten Unit 1-Shapes and Counting

In this unit students will:

- -Write and Count numbers 0-20.
- -Count to tell numbers of objects
- -Sort objects into categories
- -Name shapes to describe objects
- -Use terms such as above, below, beside, in front of, behind, and next to in order to describe relative positions of objects
- -Create addition number stories up to 20.

Home Support:

- -Practice counting sets of objects (such as shoes, stuffed animals, etc) and arranging them in different ways.
- -Practice writing numbers up to 20 by: writing numbers in the air, using a pencil or crayon to write numbers on a paper, write numbers on a white board.
- -Practice identifying shapes by showing your child shapes and having them name and sort them.
- -Practice addition stories by using child's toys such as cars, stuffed animals etc. Example: 2 cars + 2 cars
