

First Grade Unit 2-Introducing Addition

In this unit students will:

-Relate counting to addition and subtraction.

-Recognize and decompose quantities up to 20 using visual patterns.

-Add within 10 fluently.

-Add combinations of 10 automatically.

-Subtract within 10 fluently.

-Count and represent collections of objects with numerals.

-Solve number stories by adding and subtracting.

Ideas for Home:

Ten in the Bag

Place different numbers of items, such as pennies, beads, dried beans, or crayons, in clear bags. Then challenge him/her to figure out how many more items are needed in order to have a total of ten in the bag. He/She can write number sentences, or create missing addend sentences to solve.

Packs of Ten

Using the same plastic baggies from the activity above your child will subtract from 10. Subtract items and have your child find the difference for each bag. Be sure to write down number sentences to show how you added and subtracted.

Making Ten Memory

From two standard decks of cards, collect the ace through ten as well as the joker, which will represent zero. Then have your child play a game of "Memory". He or she can match the numbers that can be added together to make ten. Make sure your child writes down the number sentences during or at the end of the game.

Please note: The activities above are not homework. They are suggestions for supporting learning at home. Please consult with your child's teacher for homework and specific suggestions related to your child's needs.
