

# First Grade Unit 1-Counting

## In this unit students will:

- Solve simple number stories involving addition and subtraction within 10.
- Tell which of two numbers is larger, using a number line if necessary.
- Count up by 1s on a number grid or number line (starting at any number <100) and count a number of objects (<20), including tally marks.
- Count on from any number.
- Compare and order numbers.
- Answer questions about data
- Count to 120

## Ideas for Home:

- Practice rote counting to 120.
- Compare numbers using household items. Ex. Windows vs. doors, forks vs. spoons.
- Play top-it with a deck of cards each person turns a card and the person with the highest number keeps the card.
- Write out number stories using addition and subtraction and have child solve it.
