- Find the unknown in addition and subtraction equations.

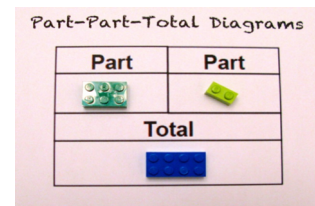
Ideas for Home:

- Write numbers 0-20
- Count objects to 20
- Adding and subtracting to 20

-LEGO for Building Part-Part-Total Thinking

LEGO bricks are awesome for part-part-total explorations! As with other popular part-part-total math manipulatives such as dominoes or dice, these bricks have clearly marked studs for students to count.



Your child can group combinations of two or more LEGO bricks and find the total number of studs, or he/she can start with a larger brick, cover part of it with a smaller brick, and figure out the amount of remaining uncovered studs.
