Re: Central Middle School Fields - Feasibility Study Update

To the Central Middle School Students, Parents, Staff and Neighbors:

As part of the process for the Central Middle School Fields feasibility study, and a follow up to our 12 April 2019 communication, the team from Milone & MacBroom (M&M) will begin excavating test pits to provide a uniform sampling of the entire field for the purpose of determining the nature of the soil, establishing the criteria for managing subsurface drainage and to identify restrictive layers.

In order to complete the work, M&M has determined that twelve (12) test pits within the confines of the school's athletic field will be created. This work had originally been planned to take place during the month of April, however the BOE in consultation with the Department of Parks and Recreation has rescheduled the work after school has recessed for the summer as to not disrupt school athletic programs.

The work has been rescheduled to start on or about 8 July 2019 and we anticipate the excavation work will be completed within 5 to 7 days weather permitting. Once the test pits have been completed and backfilled, the affected areas will remain closed off for use until new seed has germinated. Our progress will be reported and posted on the Facilities Department website.

We are excited to be progressing this work and we appreciate the cooperation of all parties involved.
