

# Second Grade Unit 4- Place Value and Measurement

## In this unit students will:

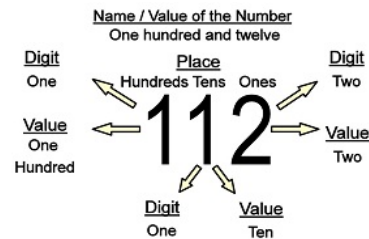
- Tell and write time using analog and digital clocks.
- Use a.m and p.m.
- Understand 3-digit place value.
- Represent whole numbers as hundreds, tens, and ones.
- Read and write numbers.
- Compare and order numbers.
- Record comparisons using  $>$ ,  $=$ , or  $<$ .
- Understand exchanging tens and hundreds.
- Add multidigit numbers using models or strategies.
- Subtract multidigit numbers using models or strategies.
- Measure the length of an object.
- Estimate lengths.
- Select appropriate tools to measure length.
- Measure an object using 2 different units of length.
