

Senior Portraits



Full body shots are not accepted.
Senior photos must be head,
head and shoulders or waist up.

- 1. Deadline to submit senior portraits: Friday October 25, 2019
- 2. Vertical, 300 resolution digital image
- 3. Printed dimensions 2.5" x 3.5"
- 4. Portraits must follow the school dress code
- Submission of portraits to the yearbook release rights for use in other publications should they be needed for honors, awards or other press purposes
- If a portrait is not received we will print the BEHS ID photo, so please be prepared in appropriate dress for your ID photo taken at registration.

It is time to plan for your senior portrait for the Brookfield East Yearbook. In order to complete the section on time and to include your student in the yearbook senior portraits must be received by Friday October 25, 2019. Portrait specifications are included below, along with instructions on how to submit your photo. Also included in this letter is information for Ads for Grads, senior yearbook quote submissions (printed under senior portraits in the yearbook) and graduation video photo submissions.

If you have not scheduled a sitting with a professional photographer, do so now if you intend to use one. Our publication is magazine quality printing, so please be advised that a snapshot is not a senior yearbook photo. Professional photos are retouched; faces properly lit and head size fits the required template. Using a professional photographer who specializes in senior photo portraiture best ensures quality printing in the yearbook. Please give our requirements to your photographer so they know what is needed for the yearbook.

Submit senior portraits to the Google Form at this link by the end of the day Friday October 25. Due to deadline requirements from our publishing company, we must adhere strictly to this deadline. Senior Quotes

The time has come to submit your final thoughts and become a part of Spartan history. Your senior quote will resonate for years to come so choose wisely.

Senior Quotes are also due on October 25, 2019 and students <u>must fill out the Google Form</u> to submit their quote. The form allows students to edit and change their submissions until the October 25 deadline. Emailed quotes will not be accepted.

There is a limit of 140 characters/spaces and you must include your source to be included in the yearbook.

Please don't waste our time by submitting an inappropriate quote. Since the yearbook is a reflection of our community, senior quotes MUST be school and community appropriate according to Elmbrook School Board policy.

Questionable quotes, lyrics to songs or any references deemed inappropriate are subject to be excluded from publication according to board policy.
