

2019-2020 Class Supply Lists for 8th Grade

Below is a general list of class supplies by course.

Students may receive additional teacher-specific requests on the first day of school.

English

- 3-ring binder (1 or 1.5 inch)
- 5 binder dividers
- Index cards (for vocabulary flash cards); optional: flash card box
- Loose-leaf paper
- Composition notebook
- Don't forget to complete your summer reading of *The Book Thief* by Markus Zusak. We will work in class with this book in the month of September. Heads-up: it's LONG (550 pages) but also a student favorite through the years. Enjoy!

History

- 3-ring binder (1.5 inch)
- 4 dividers for the 3-ring binder
- Pens and pencils
- Cornell Notebook - will be handed out in class*

Math

- TI-84 Plus Silver Edition Graphing Calculator (if purchasing) but a TI-83, 83Plus or 84 will suffice if you already have one.
- Composition Notebook
- Pencils
- Large eraser
- Multicolor pen (will be used for checking papers, and highlighting)
- Graph paper (at least 100 sheets) or coordinate plane stamp (available in the Breck Campus store)
- Geometry Template (available in the Breck Campus Store)
- Ruler (if you do not purchase a Geometry Template)
- Protractor (if you do not purchase a Geometry Template)
- 3-ring binder (1 or 1.5-inch) hard cover with pockets (exclusively for math)
- Loose-Leaf paper

Science

- 3-ring binder (1.5 or 2 inch) - Re-use of a binder from past years is best (It is ok if there is writing/personal art on the front and back from a past use)
- 1 highlighter (color does not matter)
- Pencils
- Small amount of loose leaf lined paper or small spiral notebook (reused from past years is great) approx. 25 or more sheets.

- 3-ring hole punch that can be put into one's own 3-ring binder (optional)

World Language

- 3-ring binder (for World Language only)
- Loose-leaf paper for binder
- Dividers (at least 5)
- Highlighters (several colors)
- Pens, pencils and erasers
- Index cards
- Multicolor pens

Other Items to Consider

- Small bag to attach to your computer
Great place to keep pens, pencils, erasers, index cards, calculators, etc.
- Breck Middle School Planner (you will receive this during the first week of school)
It is not necessary to purchase any other planner.
- Breck School Locker Lock
If you choose to lock your locker, you will need to use a Breck lock (available for purchase in the Breck Bookstore). All students new to Breck will receive one during the first week of school.
- Small Locker-Mate shelf (optional)
Locker shelves come in handy for storage and maximizing small locker spaces. Our lockers are a special size and the shelves bought at Office Max or Target will not fit. You can purchase shelves that will fit from the Breck Bookstore.
