



# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

*Effective for the class of 2018-2021*

CONTENT AREA	CREDITS NEEDED	EXPLANATION OF CREDITS
<b>English</b>	4	4 credits
<b>Math</b>	4	Credits must include: Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II 1 math course must be taken during the senior year.
<b>Science</b>	3	1 credit of Biology 1 credit of Chemistry, Physics or Anatomy 1 Science elective credit
<b>Social Studies</b>	3	1 credit of World History & Geography 1 credit of U.S. History & Geography 0.5 credit in Civics 0.5 credit in Economics
<b>Health &amp; Physical Education</b>	2	0.5 credit in Health Education 1.5 elective credit
<b>Visual, Performing and Applied Arts</b>	1	1 credit in Visual, Performing or Applied Arts
<b>World Languages</b>	2	2 credits of World Language
<b>Additional Credits</b>	9 to 11	Note: "additional" will specify content areas (e.g. communications, arts, etc)
<b>Advisory</b>	All students are required to pass advisory each semester they are enrolled.	
<b>Technical Competency</b>	All students must take one computer-based course during grades 9-12 (This requirement may be met by courses identified in most content areas).	
<b>Online Learning Experience</b>	All students must have an online learning experience before graduation. (This requirement can be satisfied by experiences within a regular course).	
<b>Community Service</b>	40 hours: Please see explanation in course description book. Starting with Class of 2020: Minimum one Service As Action experience per year	
<b>State of Michigan Assessment</b>	ALL JUNIORS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE STATE-REQUIRED ASSESSMENT (formerly the MME) PRIOR TO GRADUATION.	
<b>Middle Years Programme Personal Project</b>	ALL SOPHOMORES ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE MYP PERSONAL PROJECT.
