On behalf of the Delbarton Arts Council (DAC), it is our pleasure to welcome your family to Delbarton and the Arts at Delbarton. Whether your son is new to the arts or is a seasoned artist, there are so many ways for him and for you to get involved through music, performing arts, theatrical production and set design, visual arts or one of the many Delbarton publications. Participation in the arts at Delbarton will greatly contribute to your son's educational experience and will, no doubt, provide much enjoyment in the process. The Delbarton Arts community is a warm and vibrant one and we look forward to helping you become involved!

Opportunities for musicians and singers include:

- Choral groups: Schola Cantorum (traditional secular and religious choral music), Benedictones (a cappella-style pop, jazz, rock and barbershop music), and Arma Lucis (liturgical music)
- Instrumental Ensembles: Brass, wind, woodwind, jazz and percussion ensembles.
- Orchestras: Abbey (advanced orchestral arrangements) and Young Abbey (emerging string players).
  - All of the instrumental ensembles and orchestras are open to our Delbarton boys in all grades as well as adult community members and students from other schools.
- Rock Band Club: open to Delbarton male vocalists and musicians
- Winter Musical Pit Band: Provides music accompaniment for the winter musical
- Delbarton Coffeehouse events: open to individual and ensemble performances

## Performing Arts opportunities include:

- Delbarton Theater: The Abbey Players stage three major productions every year
  - o Fall Dramatic Production
  - Winter Musical Production
  - Spring One Acts Festival featuring student written and directed one-act plays
- Delbarton Stage Crew: Works "behind-the-scenes" to enhance the overall production value
  of each show. The Stage Crew team constructs all set designs, and plans and programs all
  the required lighting and sound effects, facilitates scene changes, and supports the cast in
  rehearsals and all live performances of the Abbey Players' productions. Past contributions
  include constructing a 19,000 gallon pool on stage for the fall production of
  Metamorphoses.

The Arts community is very inclusive and female students from local area schools are welcome and encouraged to audition for the many female roles that these productions make available. Audition information will be posted on the Delbarton website prior to tryouts for each production. Please visit often for updates and announcements.
