Wellness Policy

The campus coordinated checklists were sent out to all campus Principals and Colleen received all but two back so far.

As of now, the Primary campus and Kindergarten campus have some concerns that need to be discussed and addressed. The goal of the checklist is for each campus to score a Recognized score (128-134), and the Primary campus is at a 115 which is consider acceptable (the lowest rank).

It was brought up that the Primary campus is the only campus that does not allow water bottles.

Chelsea did look back during the meeting and read last year's notes from the minutes:

"The campus coordinated checklists were send out last year and didn't do well. Colleen adjusted the checklist and took off two of the measures, and re-worded items. Colleen is waiting on results and will present at the next subcommittee meeting."

Hope is going to ask Matt what LaPorte ISD does, and Missy will be looking into Sheldon ISD's process.

Colleen is going to look at the scoring checklist and see if any adjustments need to be made.
