



Internship Program:

Final Year of High School





A one-year internship program for students with disabilities in last year of high school. Must be at age 18+ by program start date. Takes place in healthcare setting in Allegheny County.

Total immersion in the workplace facilitates the teaching and learning process as well as the acquisition of employability and marketable work skills. Students participate in three internships to explore a variety of career paths.

Grades 9-10





College Bound is a half-day event for students with disabilities in grades 9 and 10 featuring various activities, and presentations on: OVR, Supportive Service, and Career Services.

CCAC Allegheny Campus - March 27, 2019. CCAC South Campus - April 4, 2019.



Career Bound is a half-day event for students with disabilities in grades 9 and 10 featuring presentations, activities, and live demonstrations of four vocational training programs: Food Service, Environmental Services, Building Maintenance, and Healthcare Professional.

CCAC North Campus - April 5, 2019.

Grades 11-12+





University for a Day is half-day event for students with disabilities in grades 11 and 12 featuring: Admissions, and Center for Student Success Presentations, Campus Tour, RISE Center Tour and Demonstrations.

Launch Academy

Launch Academy is a 5 day event (M-F) for students with disabilities aged 16-21. Completed Launch application required. Students participate in various activities focused on career exploration and workplace readiness such as: college tours, workplace tours, presentations & mock interviews.

Experience College: Final Year of High School





A One Credit Course designed specifically for high school seniors with learning differences who desire an opportunity to explore post-secondary options. Students will focus on effective strategies for transitioning from a high school setting to a post-secondary education.




