

Fourth Grade Unit 1- Place Value

In this unit students will:

- Read, write, and identify places in numbers.
- Compare and order multi-digit whole numbers.
- Record multi-digit whole-number comparisons using $<$, $>$, $=$,
- Use place-value understanding to round whole numbers to any place.
- Explain the relationship and convert between yards, feet, and inches.
- Find perimeter using a strategy.
- Draw and label points, lines, line segments, and rays with help from the student resource book.
- Identify right angles.
- Add and subtract within 100 using a number grid and strategies based on place value.

Home Support:

- Write a long number and challenge your fourth grader to read it aloud.
- To practice place value, here's a fun hands-on activity to get your child flipping through place value.
- Challenge your child to find lines, rays, and right angles around the house, then draw what they find.
