

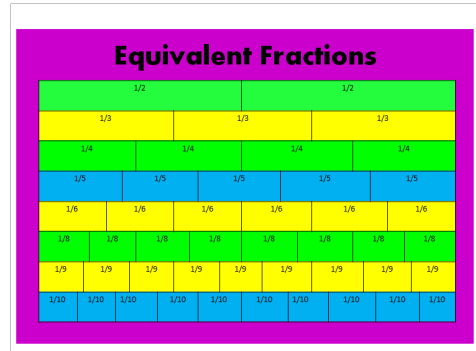
Fourth Grade Unit 3- Fractions and Decimals

- Name decimals using words and base-ten numerals.
- Translate between decimal notation and fractions with denominators 10 or 100.
- Represent decimals to hundredths.
- Compare and order decimals.
